MOORINGS

Complementary moorings are available for the duration of the regatta. Please reach out to the NBYC Office, (508) 997 -0762 or use DockWa to book your mooring, please make note that you are part of our regatta.

South Wharf Yacht Yard, located next door to NBYC may have slips available, contact them for availability, (508) 990-1011.

FUEL DOCK: Fresh water, fuel (diesel and marine gas), block and cubed ice, and lubricating oils may be obtained at the Gas Shack on the North Dock, daily from 8 AM to 7 PM through mid-October. Ice is also available from the Launch attendant or at Club Office. There is a 20-minute tie up limit at the dock. We do allow boats to pick up crew at the North or South floats.

There is limited dinghy tie up located on the shoreside of the Launch base.

Launch Service: *BLUE, ORCA* and *WHALE*, the Club launches, run daily from 8 AM – 10 PM with shorter hours after Labor Day. They may be summoned by hailing "NBYC Launch" on VHF 68.

Garbage and Trash: Your cooperation is earnestly requested in keeping our Harbor clean. Dumpsters are located on the Club grounds, as are recycling containers.

THE CLUBHOUSE

The Office is open daily between 8 AM – 10 PM, with shorter hours after Labor Day.

The Dining room and deck bar are open for Lunch and Dinner Wednesday through Sunday. Lunch service is from noon to 2pm and dinner service starts at 5pm.

Showers and bathrooms are located on the South side of the Club House. Please come to the office if the keypad code is needed and we will assist you.

Pets are part of your crew, and we welcome them on our launches and ashore. Your four-legged crew must be kept on a leash at all times while on NBYC grounds and in the Village per Town of Dartmouth regulations. They are not allowed in the Club House. Please respect our grounds and pick up after your pet. “Pick Up” mitt dispensers are located by the recycling bins at the end of the dock.
