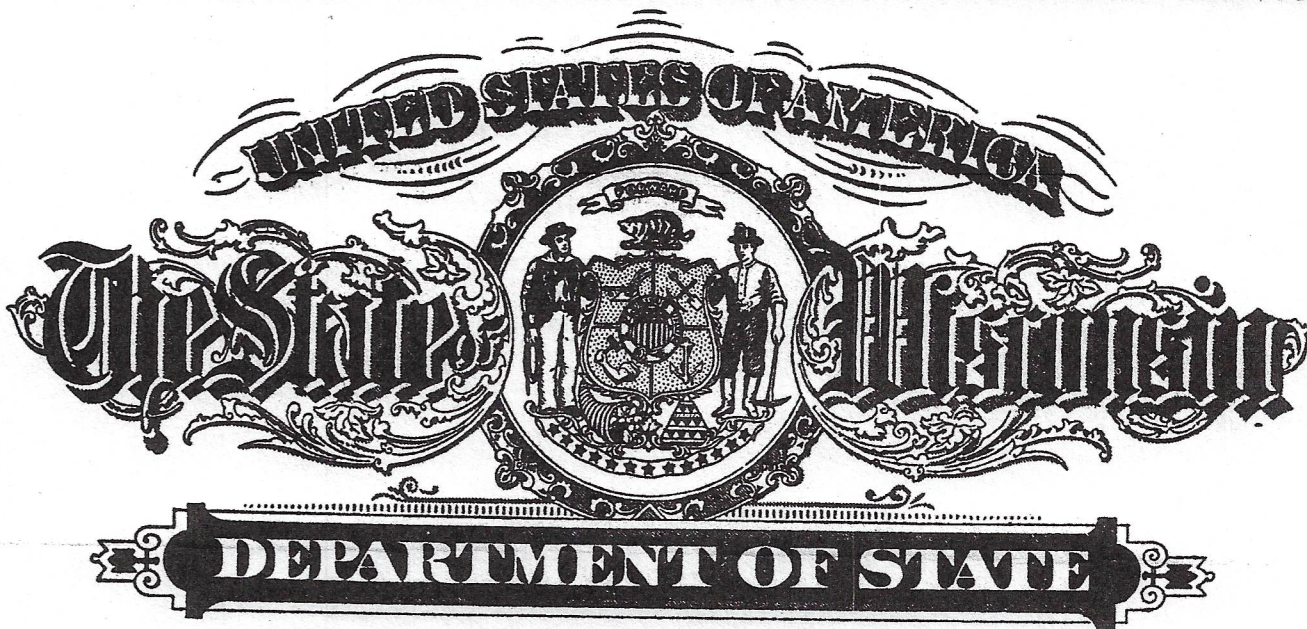

By these presents, that the undersigned, adult residents of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby make, sign and agree to the following:

ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION.

ARTICLE FIRST.—The undersigned have associated, and do hereby associate themselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under chapter 86, of the Revised Statutes of the State of Wisconsin, for the year A. D. 1878, and the acts amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, the business and purposes of which corporation shall be

To advance the interests of Hunting, Fishing and other aquatic sports, and the protection of Game & Fish.

which said business is to be carried on within the State of Wisconsin, and especially within the County of Walworth in said State.

ARTICLE SECOND.—The name of said corporation shall be The Lake Teuch Club

and its location shall be in the State of Wisconsin, Post Office Lake Teuch, Wisconsin.

ARTICLE THIRD.—The capital stock of said corporation shall be

and the same shall consist of shares, each of which said shares shall be of the face or par value of

ARTICLE FOURTH.—The general officers of said corporation shall be a President, Vice-President Secretary and Treasurer, Captain & Ensign and the Board of Directors shall consist of 5 stockholders.

ARTICLE FIFTH.—The principal duties of the President shall be to preside at all meetings of the Board of Directors, and to have a general supervision of the affairs of the corporation.

The Commodore The Commodore The principal duties of the Vice-President shall be to discharge the duties of the President in the

The principal duties of the Treasurer shall be to keep and account for all moneys, credits and property, of any and every nature, of the corporation, which shall come into his hands, and to keep an accurate account of all moneys received and disbursed, and proper vouchers for moneys disbursed, and to render such accounts, statements and inventories of moneys received and disbursed, and of money and property on hand, and generally of all matters pertaining to this office, as shall be required by the Board of ^{Trustees} Directors.

The Board of ^{Trustees} Directors may provide for the appointment of such additional officers as they may deem for the best interests of the ^{Club} corporation.

Whenever the Board of ^{Trustees} Directors may so order, the offices of Secretary and Treasurer may be held by the same person.

The said officers shall perform such additional or different duties as shall from time to time be imposed or required by the Board of ^{Trustees} Directors, or as may be prescribed from time to time by the by-laws.

ARTICLE SIXTH.—Only persons holding stock according to the regulations of the corporation shall be members of it.

ARTICLE SEVENTH.—These articles may be amended by resolution setting forth such amendment or amendments, adopted at any meeting of the stockholders by a vote of at least two-thirds of all the stock of said corporation then outstanding.
