Lake Beulah Yacht Club is an all-volunteer club. In keeping with the spirit of volunteerism, members are asked to chair and/or host at least one party each season. The following instructions will ensure that the LBYC Social Events run smoothly, and that the Club is ready for the next event.

COMMITTEES

- A. Each season, Social Committees are assigned by the LBYC Social Chair and published in the LBYC Yearbook. Committee Chairs are responsible for reminding committee members of the upcoming event and organizing the event.
- B. If a member is unable to fulfill his or her social committee assignment, the member has the responsibility to exchange social committee assignments with another LBYC member or find a substitute to serve on the member's assigned committee.
- C. The Mainsheet shall be used to notify LBYC members of a social event. Each committee is responsible for publicizing their event. Any notices should include a reservations deadline and cost per person.

BAR

- Bar receipts are kept separate from party income. Bar receipts are not to be included in a budget for any social event.
- B. A bartender licensed by the Town of East Troy must be on the premises when the bar is open. A number of LBYC members are licensed bartenders. Check with the Social Chair for a list of licensed bartenders. Any adult member of LBYC may tend bar.
- C. All alcoholic beverages must be purchased by the Social Chair. No alcoholic beverages may be brought into the Club or onto the premises per state statute.

RESERVATIONS, REFUNDS & CANCELLATION POLICY

- A. Reservations will be by check, credit card or by RSVP.
- B. Each committee may ask the secretary to contact members by email to encourage attendance.
- C. No refunds shall be given for paid reservations. Food purchases are made based on advance reservations.
- Cancellation of an event must be approved by the Social Chair.



FINANCIAL

- Each committee considering the use of a caterer or entertainment must present a budget to the LBYC Social Chair for approval.
- B. Any contracts or written agreements for a caterer or entertainment must be signed by the Social Chair.
- C. In establishing the price for a major social event, please include a profit of at least \$2 per person.
- D. Instructions on cash boxes for an event will be given to each committee chair on the social event report form.
- E. No money may be removed from the cash boxes for payment of expenses related to the event.
- F. Committee members will be reimbursed by the LBYC Treasurer for any expenses incurred upon submission of the social event Financial Report. Please include receipts for any expenses incurred. The Treasurer will reimburse expenses from receipts. The social event Financial report form should be submitted within 48 hours of event.

BEFORE THE EVENT

- Check paper supplies, condiments and leftovers in cooler and freezer for possible use.
- B. Contact Social Chair as to any special needs.
- C. Adjust heating/air conditioning as appropriate.
- D. Decorations may be available at the Club. Please check the storage closet and under the trophy cabinets.

AFTER THE PARTY

- A. Leftover food must be stored, sold, given away, or thrown out. Leftover food must be covered, identified and dated. Please contact the next party if you store food usable for the next occasion.
- The club must be left clean. Clean up instructions are posted in the LBYC kitchen
- C. Complete the social event report as soon as possible after the event. This form will help the next committee with its planning, especially menus and quantities.
- D. Return cash boxes and complete the Financial Report Form as instructed above, under the section "Financial".

All members are scheduled to volunteer for at least one social event. It is often necessary for some of our members to serve multiple events. If a member is unable to serve at the assigned event, it is the member's responsibility to trade with another member for a different event. Subscribing and junior members are not scheduled for social obligations. In addition, those memberships with individuals over 80 years of age as of January 1, 2019 may opt not to be scheduled for social obligations if they request an exemption. Thanks for your participation. The volunteerism of our club membership makes our events successful.

Bartending policy – One licensed bartender shall be on the premises. Any committee member may serve behind the bar.





The service of alcohol in the building and on the grounds of the Lake Beulah Yacht Club is reviewed by the LBYC Board of Directors. LBYC holds a Class B license, which regulates the sale of fermented malt beverages and intoxicating liquor. Please contact us for any special needs.

- All alcohol (which includes beer hereafter) served at the Club shall be purchased by the Social Chair or by the Chair's representative. Alcohol may not be brought into the Club or onto the premises. Alcohol may not be removed from the Club for LBYC – sponsored events away from the Club.
- 2. The price of alcoholic and carbonated beverages served at the Club shall be established annually by the LBYC Board of Directors.
- A bartender holding an operator's license issued by the Town of East Troy must be present at the Club for any events at which any alcoholic beverages are served.
 Bartenders will be assigned and scheduled in advance by the social/rental/bar chair for all events.
- 4. Bartenders will be hired for all rentals using bar service and will be paid by the renter at the rate established by the Board. Refer to the rental policy for further description of rentals. The Social Chair or designee shall confirm bartender responsibilities before approving the private rental. Multiple bartenders may be required, depending on the size of the event. A club member qualified as a bartender (see Item 3) may volunteer to serve as bartender for a rental function, in which case the bartender fee will be waived.

- 5. No person under 21 years of age shall be served nor issued alcohol by bartenders or other persons.
- 6. Regular inventory and brands shall be determined by the Social Chair. A member/renter may request non-inventory beverages which will be delineated in the rental contract or to the social/bar/rental chair. A four-week lead time is strongly recommended. This policy applies for rentals, private parties or club events. The renter/event chair will specify the quantity to be purchased and the renter/event is responsible for the cost of any excess at the end of the event. Regular bar prices will apply to specialty drinks, or the normal profit margin, whichever is greater.
- 7. All club events (regattas, club social events, rentals) where free or reduced price drinks are offered shall reimburse the bar at regular bar prices.
- 8. On an annual basis, the Social Chair shall compile a list of individuals who will be used to fill bartending duties for club rentals.



















