House & Grounds

The LBYC clubhouse building is ready. The crane hoist is installed, the piers painted, new kitchen modifications are complete and another work day has prepared the building for summer.

Tennis/Pickleball Courts

The tennis courts were resurfaced today for the 2023 season. Two pickleball courts have been added to the Western court. The Pickleball lines are a contrasting color. The pickleball court will be rolled at a different rate than the tennis court to maintain the playing surface as recommended by C.R. Peterson the court resurfacing contractor.

Irrigation Works has started the court watering system. The sprinkler heads were cleaned but the electrical connection to the pump failed to energize after being submerged in the channel. An electrician replaced the reset switch the week of May 15. The 20 year old control panel at the tennis court screen was replaced. The new panel can be controlled with a WIFI connection.

Holding Tanks

The holding tank have been pumped twice already during this young season. Based upon the quantities pumped in these nearly back to back pumping's separated only by work day, I would estimate the total capacity at 7,000 gallons. Our typical pumping is around 3,000 gallons; \$165.00 per pumping.

A new toilet was required this spring in the women's bathroom. The existing tank was leaking water onto the floor and the required gasket had been discontinued by the manufacturer. Joe's Plumbing replaced the toilet on May 19.

Work Day

Another successful work week and day has come and gone. 27 people participated throughout the week. The entire work schedule had been completed by 11:00 on Saturday, May 6, morning.

Randy (Chip) Inman was a one man work crew moving all of the lawn and patio furniture from the shed; power washing chairs and tables on the West lawn.

The wooden launch ladder at the crane was put back in the water. The ladder was weighted down with three (3) concrete masonry units roped to the ladder framework with steel cable. Launch Team: David Porter, Christine McNeil, Brad McNeil.



The piers were recoated with a white opaque stain. Pier Painting Crew: Dan Uhen, Pat Thomas, Greg Thomas, Tom Atkinson, Barb Atkinson.

Conditioned Air Design

After the spring preventative maintenance the following repair work was recommended for the two (2) grade mounted air handling units.

Scope: North Building Air Handling Unit (Dining Room, Kitchen)

- Disconnect wiring to condenser motor and remove the failing motor, fan blade and capacitor.
- Install the new Trane OEM condenser motor, blade and capacitor.
- Reconnect the wiring to the motor making sure rotation is correct.

Scope: East Building Air Handling Unit (Foyer, Bar Office Area)

- Remove the worn and pitted compressor and indoor blower contactors.
- Install the new Trane contactors for all 3 components; verify wiring.

Total Price of Investment: \$1,762.00 dollars

The work was accomplished on Wednesday, May 17. These 23 year old heating, ventilating and air conditioning units are consistently requiring repairs to blowers, heat exchangers, bearings and motors. The twice a year maintenance replaces worn belts, changes filters, monitors the control panels and cleans the condenser coils. A replacement of a failed machine would be expensive and require long lead times.

COURT RESERVATION SYSTEM NOW ONLINE

The new reservation system for the LBYC courts will allow tennis and pickleball play simultaneously. The East (shaded) court will only be utilized for tennis. The West (lake) court may be reserved for tennis or pickleball (two courts). If you are planning to use the West court for pickleball, please check that it is not reserved for tennis and vice versa. The system is setup to allow watering of the courts and tennis lessons to co-exist with your playing schedule. Select your desired date from the dropdown on the left. Then choose your court and time.

You must be a paid court member to reserve at this time.
