Courts

The Tennis/ Pickleball Courts are available for reservations. Since both sports are playable in a standard doubles format one person is required to reserve the court for four for an hour.

Pickleball is sometimes played with more people waiting to play than the doubles format. One person can reserve a court for multiple players. Each player can reserve a playing spot on the court by inserting their paddle in the tennis enclosing fence as a placeholder for next player up. It sounds more complicated than it actually is.

The watering of the courts this spring was complicated by pump problems at the channel where the water to irrigate the clay courts comes from. There are two pumps supplying water to the court sprinkler heads. A main pump and a booster pumper which increases water pressure and the arc of the water spray from the head. The booster pump connection to the power source was short circuiting the electrical circuit and shutting off the main breaker. This problem is currently being remediated by Irrigation Works and the full court sprinkler section back up and running by Mainsheet Publication.

Conditioned Air Design

The existing heating and air conditioning system has under gone repairs suggested at the spring preventative maintenance inspection and the air conditioning system is ready to keep us comfortable over the summer months.

LBSS Pier Location

The Sailing School pier location has been adjusted by Complete Piers; moving the Opti Ramps and LBSS pier approximately 10 feet to the North off the spring installed location. The Opti ramps were nested in a tight configuration to prevent gaps in the sections. This was accomplished by Complete Piers at the request of the Lake Beulah Sailing School.

Plumbing Issues

A damaged kitchen pot filling plumbing faucet was repaired by Joe's Plumbing the very day a request was made (we should thank Mitzy Dorn who we piggy-backed our service request). This averted a complication to the Wednesday night cookout logistics. The control valve below the sink was turned off during the Shea/ Roble fundraiser event.

Holding Tanks

The holding sanitary tanks are inspected on a weekly basis during the summer and are typically pumped every two weeks.

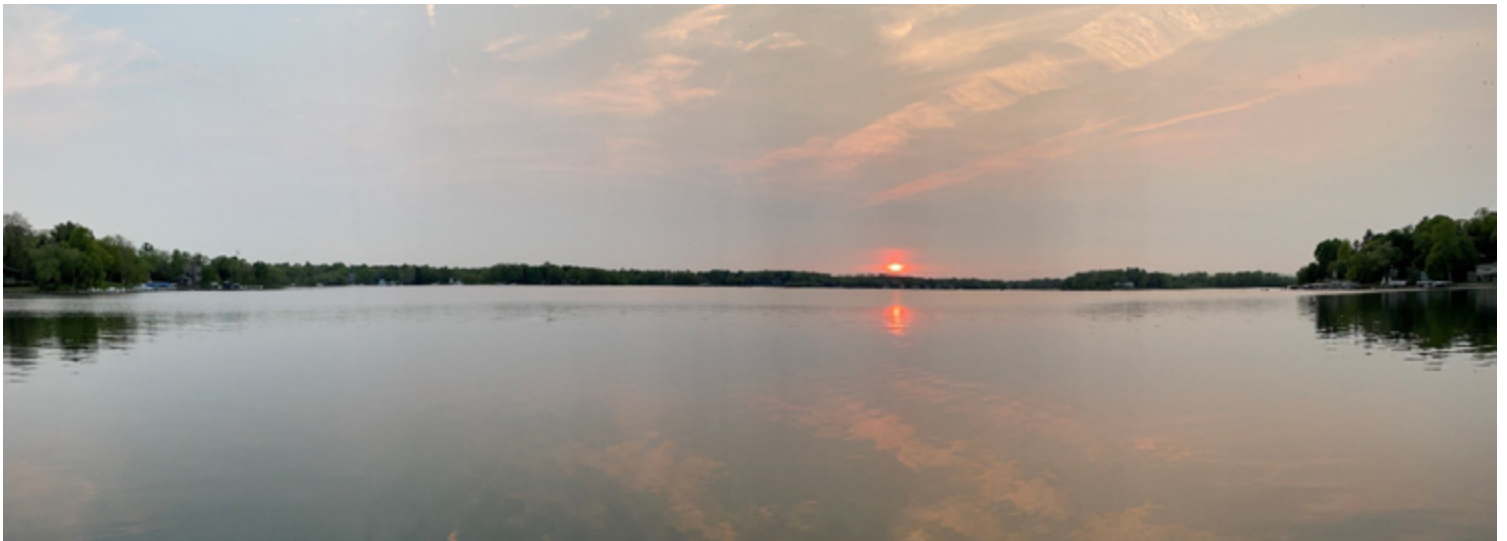
The two tanks located uphill of the Sally's Playground buried pumping station have a maximum capacity of 7,000 gallons.

Toilet Exhaust Air

Did you know that the lights in the Men's Toilet room are interconnected with a roof mounted exhaust fan which remove adulterated (I'm sorry, what more could I say) conditioned air from both toilet room building interiors. Please turn off the light when you are exiting the bathrooms to conserve energy.

Outdoor Summer Use of LBYC

The exterior site of the LBYC grounds continues to be treated for insects during the summer and fall months. This program was started during 2020 to maintain social distancing protocol and continues this year. An additional benefit of the program is insect control at Sally's Playground in the form of nesting wasps in the playground equipment.
