Volleyball Court

Court boundary lines were purchased for the Volleyball Court in preparation for the Quad regatta Volleyball games. These are adjustable 2inch wide boundary lines used by the professional volleyball tour.

Made of heavy duty color fading treated yellow webbing each corner is staked into the ground with a bungee cord adjustable tension connection. The size of the court is also adjustable with mid-line buckle connection.

Assistance in the court layout was offered by Mike Greeson's surveying equipment; professional down to the smallest detail.

Holding Tanks
