The DCYC Youth Sailing program is planned to be available in 2023 to new or experienced sailors ages 8-13 (reasonable age exceptions considered on a case-by-case basis). While this class is open to new sailors, those children with experience are encouraged to apply because they will have an opportunity to improve their sailing proficiency. Our sailing coaches are experienced racers and cruisers.

Learn the Basics, Improve Existing Skills



The program focuses on developing and/or improving sailing skills; classes are taught in Optimist Prams, RS Tera, O'pen Skiff, and sometimes in a P-15 Sloop.

The youth sailors will learn the basics of rigging and sailing in straight lines on and off the wind; capsize recovery; identifying points of sail; how to leave and return to a dock; wind direction; and sail trim. They may practice how to start a race and make their way around a racecourse. They will be taught about the responsibility of caring for the boats and equipment. Knot tying lessons are part of the curriculum.

Sail a multi-crew dinghy

Sometimes, during the class schedule, the children will have an opportunity to crew on a larger dinghy with their coaches to learn how it differs from a one-person dinghy; how to tack a jib using sheets; how to steer a sloop on all points of sail; and how to raise and lower the sails; and adjust the main and jib sheets for proper sail trim.

These are sailing classes during which the primary focus is on learning to sail and/or improving existing sailing skills. It is different from DCYC's



sensational, summer sailing camps which tend be a balance between summertime fun and a relaxed sailing theme.

Coaches/Instructors/Boats

Dallas Corinthian Yacht Club has club-owned sailboats available for sailing class students to use. The coach or coaches will be on-the-water providing guidance and safety from a motor-driven chase boat. Our coaches/instructors are mature, patient, enthusiastic, safety-conscious, highly experienced racers/cruisers. Safe boating and safe behavior at the Club is the top priority of all concerned. Our classes are relatively small to provide proper instruction to the young sailors. All students must pass DCYC's basic swim skills test, wear a helmet, and wear an approved PFD (life jacket).

[Group Make-up date May 20, 2023 - if necessary] Tuition is just \$117 for nonmembers and \$97 for members, per child, for the 3- class program.
