Bass River Sailing School – 2024 Welcome Letter

We are excited for the summer of 2024. Registration is now open on the Clubspot network. The link and other important information is on the BRYC website under the Youth Sailing tab on our website: www.Bassriveryachtclub.org

Each year we strive to apply lessons learned in the prior summer to refine our program. For 2024 we have made a few important changes to highlight.

- The minimum age for Learn to Sail is 6 years old and all students (including Learn to Sail) must be able to swim 25 yards without the use of a PFD. Registration confirms this ability.
- We are limiting the number of Learn to Sail students to ensure an appropriate staff/student ratio. This will vary week-by-week depending upon availability of instructors. BRYC members take priority. Please register early to avoid disappointment.
- While we prefer registrations for multiple weeks, a single week registration is allowed.
- Payment on Clubspot can be done by electronic check or by credit card. Payment by credit care adds the processing fee. For members registering for the entire summer, this can be paid by personal check at the start of the summer.
- The rules as published are essentially the same as in prior years but will be more strictly enforced, particularly the adherence to the 5mph speed limit on the driveway. Failure to adhere to the rules may result in expulsion from the school.
- Refunds are generally not provided but if a refund is made due to special circumstances, the refund will be less fees related to any Clubspot fees.
- ALL REGISTRATIONS ARE SUBJECT TO SCHOOL APPROVAL.
