Parking Ordinances & Under Age Drinking/Open Container:

Parking passes are available for a fee from the Marina Office. The pass does not guarantee a parking space, but your vehicle will not be ticketed while you're out racing. Parking passes can be used only in the Harbormaster parking lot.

The city offers free parking throughout. If you need trailer storage, there is a lot behind City Hall (Zoll St & Penn Ave) where your trailer can be stored for \$5 a day. Passes can be picked up at the Police Station next to City Hall between 8:00 am and 5:00 pm.

Consumption of Alcohol at Dock - the Harbor Springs Police Department will allow open alcohol only on the West Dock at the City Marina but will be exercising zero tolerance once you leave the dock itself. Please don't take open beverages off the docks into town and enjoy responsibly on the dock.

LTYC EMERGENCY EVACUATION PLAN

- 1. Call PRO on VHF radio. Give:
 - Boat Name
 - Type of emergency or injury
 - M/F, Age
 - Approximate Lat/Long of boat
- 2. PRO will call 911 and an emergency RIB will be dispatched from Harbor Springs and/or Emmet County.
- **3.** The emergency RIB will transport the patient to the closest waterfront (Harbor Springs or Petoskey). There the patient will be transferred to an ambulance and taken to McLaren Northern Michigan Hospital.
