 As you know, arbitration is a short meeting without witnesses to determine if a penalty less than disqualification is appropriate to offer to one or more parties to this protest. I will listen to both accounts of this incident, ask some questions, then give my opinion about how we should move forward.
 - 3.2 If the parties are **not comfortable** with arbitration, give this description:
 This arbitration is a short meeting where I will give my opinion about the likely outcome if this goes to a protest hearing. In this meeting, I will listen to the party accounts of the incident, then ask questions to form my opinion. There are no witnesses in this meeting. After I hear from the parties, I will offer one of three opinions. First, I might give the opinion that the protest is invalid, or no boat broke a rule and recommend withdrawal of the protest. Second, I might have the opinion that this needs to go to a full hearing because something I heard means this incident cannot be resolved within the arbitration rules. Finally, I might have the opinion that one or more of you have broken a rule and are likely to be penalized. If that is my opinion, the parties will have the opportunity to take a scoring penalty of 30% [may be modified by NOR] prior to the hearing. If a penalty is taken by all parties who I think broke a rule, the protestor will have the option to withdraw the protest. Do you have any questions?
