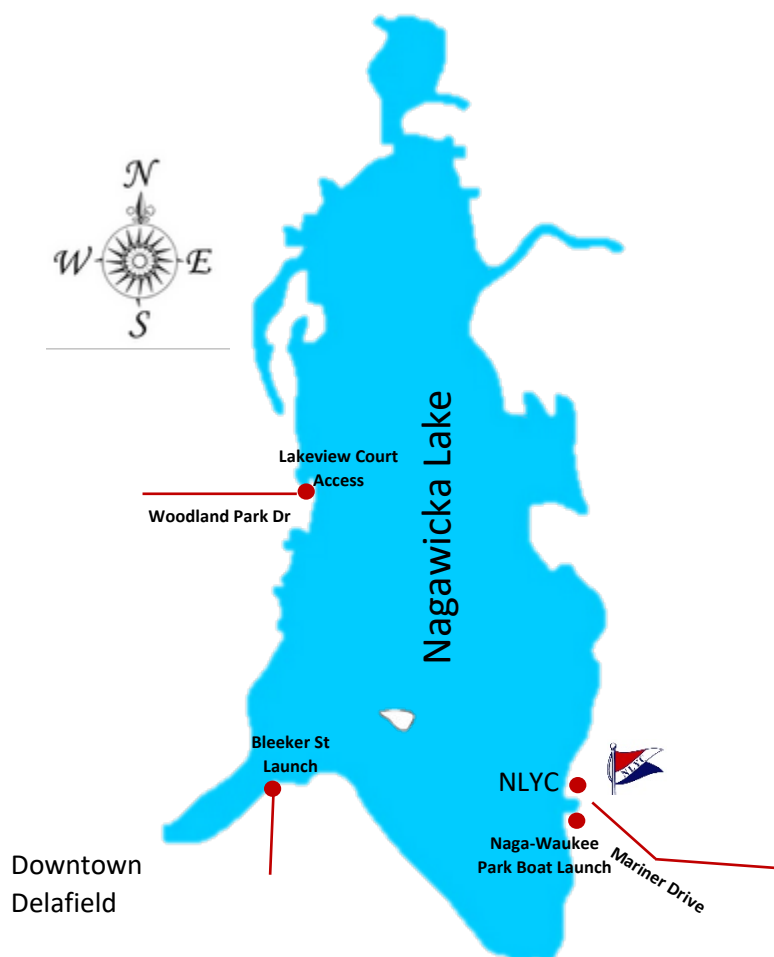


# Emergency Safety Plan

Meet emergency personnel at these access points



### Be prepared to tell 9-1-1:

- Current location of injured person
- Description of boats (if requesting on-water help)
- Where you plan to bring injured person ashore (see below)
- Age/gender/number of injured people
- Type of injury/situation
- Your name and call back number

In the meantime – Render assistance, monitor and administer first aid, call PRO, send someone to meet emergency vehicles if needed. Transfer injured person under supervision of EMS, debrief and inform key people, **DO NOT SPEAK TO PRESS OR ANY OTHER THAN EMS OR POLICE**, complete incident report, if advised.

There is an ILYA-supplied safety boat on the race course. Please utilize VHF CH72 for assistance.

Use **VHF CH 68** to communicate with Lake Country Fire & Rescue (when calling 9-1-1, tell them you will be using this channel). The Nagawicka RC will be on channel 72. Please reach out to the PRO if you need more info.

Hospitals – Aurora Summit – I-94 and 67 south.

Oconomowoc Memorial – I-94 and 67 north.

Waukesha Memorial – I-94 east and follow hospital signs. American Ave
