SUPPLEMENTAL SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1 CHANGES TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1.1 Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted before 0900 on the day it will take effect, except that any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 2000 on the day before it will take effect. This changes the Notice of Race

2 COMMUNICATIONS WITH COMPETITORS

- 2.1 The official notice board will be on the east ground floor veranda of the island clubhouse.
2.3 The race committee will monitor VHF channel 09.
2.2 On the water, the race committee may make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. Failure to hail will not be grounds for a redress for request. This changes RRS 62.1(a).

3 CODE OF CONDUCT

- 3.1 [DP] Competitors shall comply with reasonable requests from race officials.

4 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 4.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed at the flag pole located outside of Sailing Office, which is located south of the Island Clubhouse.

5 RACE AREA

- 5.1 Races will take place in Toronto Harbour and Lake Ontario South of Toronto Island.

6 THE START

- 6.1 The starting line is between a staff displaying an orange flag on the signal vessel and the course side of the starting mark.

7 THE FINISH

- 7.1 The finishing line is between a staff displaying a blue flag on the signal vessel and the course side of the finish mark.

8 HEARING REQUESTS

- 8.1 The protest time limit is 60 minutes after the docking time of the signal vessel. Protests are not encouraged as these are fun races but in the case of damage they will be heard. The time will be posted on the official notice board.
8.2 Hearing request forms are available from the Sailing Office.

8.3 Hearings will be held at a time mutually convenient to all parties.

9 SAFETY REGULATIONS

9.1 [DP] A boat that retires from a race shall notify the race committee at the first reasonable opportunity.

10 TRASH DISPOSAL

10.1 Trash may be placed aboard official [or support person] vessels.

11 DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS

11.1 Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around keelboats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the last race of the event.
