



NOTICE OF RACE ORF Short Handed

Skippers Meeting 8:00 am

Start 10:00 am

1. **RULES:** The regatta shall be governed by the 2021 - 2024 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), US Sailing prescriptions and the KYC Standing Sailing Instructions all as may be modified by this NOR
2. **ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY and FEES:** The races are open to all sailboats owned or chartered by members of Kaneohe Yacht Club with a maximum of two persons aboard. Boats of other organizations may be invited by the fleet captain upon request. Eligible boats may enter by emailing intent to enter to Frederic Berg by text at (808) 284-4221 with boat name, skipper name, boat type, rating and length. There is no entry fee.
3. **CLASSES:**
 - 3.1. Double Handed Class
 - 3.2. Cruising Class (if requested).
4. **SPECIAL CONDITIONS:**
 - 4.1. Max Two persons on board.
 - 4.2. Autopilots allowed.
 - 4.3. Monitor VHF channel 68 throughout the race
5. **SCHEDULE of EVENTS:**
 - 5.1. Skippers' Meeting: 8:00 am In front of the KYC bar
 - 5.2. First Start: 10:00 am
6. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** The KYC Standing Sailing Instructions shall be used and are available at the Kaneohe Yacht Club or on the KYC website: www.kaneoheyachtclub.com.
7. **VENUE** The racing shall take place in and around Kaneohe Bay.
8. **COURSE:** (subject to change at the skipper's meeting)
 - 8.1. Alt course 1: Start at Main Ship Channel "R 26" and KYC "C" mark. Leave Sampan Channel "R-2" to starboard. Leave Mokumanu Island to starboard. Round Rabbit Island to starboard. Leave Mokumanu Island to port. Leave Sampan Channel "R 2" to port. Finish between Main Ship Channel "R 26" and KYC "C" mark. (Approximately 34 mi)
 - 8.2. Alt course 2: Start at Main Ship Channel "R 26" and KYC "C" mark. Leave Main Ship Channel "K" Buoy to starboard. Round Mololea Rock (Bird S__t Island) to starboard. Leave Sampan Channel "R 2" Buoy to port. Finish between Main Ship Channel "R 26" and KYC "C" mark. (Approximately 22 mi.)
 - 8.3. Skippers to take their own finish times and text to Frederic Berg at (808) 284-4221, include your name and vessel name. No verbal or paper finish times will be accepted. All times are in cellular telephone time (use your phone).
 - 8.4. Course subject to change at Skipper's meeting.

- 9. PENALTY SYSTEM:** Rule 44.1 shall be in effect and modified to require only one turn.
- 10. SCORING:** The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A4.1 shall apply.
- 11. PRIZES:** The honor of racing a yacht short handed is an honor to be cherished. No other prizes will be awarded so as to not diminish this honor. Race results, if available, will be announced after the races at the KYC piano bar area or by email.
