



NOTICE OF RACE
ORF Single Handed
March 11, 2023

1. **RULES:** The regatta shall be governed by the 2021 - 2024 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), US Sailing prescriptions and the KYC Standing Sailing Instructions. Kaneohe Yacht Club (KYC) is the organizing authority.
2. **ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY and FEES:** The races are open to all sailboats owned or chartered by members of Kaneohe Yacht Club. Other boats may be invited by the fleet captain. Eligible boats may enter by texting intent to enter to Frederic Berg (808) 284-4221 with boat name, type, length, PHRF rating and skipper name. There is no entry fee.
3. **CLASSES:** Single Handed Class.
4. **SPECIAL CONDITIONS:**
 - 4.1. No Spinnakers
 - 4.2. Auto pilots are allowed.
5. **SCHEDULE of EVENTS:**
 - 5.1. Skippers' Meeting: 8:00 am (at the piano bar)
 - 5.2. Starting Time: 10:00 am
6. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** The KYC Standing Sailing Instructions shall be used and are available at the Kaneohe Yacht Club or on the KYC website: www.kaneoheyachtclub.com.
7. **VENUE and COURSE:**
 - 7.1. The racing shall take place in and around Kaneohe Bay and Kailua Bay.
 - 7.2. Alt 1: Start west of Sampan Channel "G 5" aligned with Crashboat Channel "G 3"; leave "R-2" to starboard, pass to port of Mokumanu until Rabbit Island is visible, then turn to port and head back to R-2, enter Sampan Channel leaving "R-2" to port; finish west of Sampan Channel "G 5" aligned with Crashboat Channel "G 3". All aids to navigation shall be observed. Time stamped photo of Rabbit Island required. Skippers to take their own finish times and report to Frederic Berg via text at (808) 284-4221, including time stamped photo.
 - 7.3. Alt 2: Start at Main Ship Channel "R 26" and KYC "C" mark. Leave Main Ship Channel "K" Buoy to starboard. Leave Sampan Channel "R 2" Buoy to starboard. Finish between Main Ship Channel "R 26" and KYC "C" mark.
 - 7.4. Skippers are to take their own finish times and text finish times to Frederic Berg at (808) 284-4221, include your name and vessel name. No verbal, email or paper finish times will be accepted. All times are in cellular telephone time (use the time on your phone).
 - 7.5. Course subject to change at the Skippers Meeting
8. **SAFETY**
 - 8.1. Each skipper is responsible for their own safety.
9. **PENALTY SYSTEM:** Rule 44.1 shall be modified to require only one turn.
10. **PRIZES:** The honor of racing a yacht single handed is the greatest prize conceivable. No other prizes will be awarded so as to not diminish this honor.
