

## SAN DIEGO ASSOCIATION OF YACHT CLUBS Minutes for Dinner Meeting Held December 10, 2020

Commodore Poltorak called the virtual meeting to order at 6:30PM and led the pledge of allegiance as a staff commodore of MBYC.

Commodore Poltorak then recognized MBYC Past Commodore and SDAYC Past Commodore who proposed a toast to the success of the MBYC Board of Directors during the 2021 yachting season.

Commodore Poltorak then recognized MBYC Commodore Gene Ratliffe who introduced his board members.

Commodore Poltorak then recognized the SDAYC Staff Commodores present.

Commodore Poltorak called for approval of the minutes for the November 19, 2020 Dinner Meeting and a motion was made and carried (M/C) to accept them as written.

Commodore Poltorak then began introducing the SDAYC Board of Directors for their reports:

Representative Phil Kinnison: No report.

Treasurer Bob Ehlers: He made comments about the past year; stated the books are closed out for 2020.

Junior Director Jim Murtland: No report.

Senior Director Wayne Strickland: He also made comments about the past year and what SDAYC did to help us get through it.

Rear Commodore Bill Edwards: Reported that the Bylaws amendments had been unanimously approved by the delegates and would be posted on the website in the coming week. He gave out a shout out to the delegate who participated.

Vice Commodore Dianna Durgin: Stated the Racing Calendar is at the printers and she will distribute them after they are received next week.

Junior Staff Commodore Margo Hemond: No report.

Commodore Poltorak: Introduced his wife Belen.

Commodore Poltorak then began the roll call of Regular Member, Associate and Affiliate Clubs as well as Liaison Members for their reports:

CCYC: Dianna Durgin noted that their club is closed except for takeout.



CYC: Wayne Strickland noted they are sailing the remote control boating, regattas cancelled and are doing takeout.

MBYC: Commodore Gene Ratliffe thanked SDAYC for getting us sailing and he announced that a couple of club races are coming out and that they too are providing food takeout.

NYCSD: Vice Commodore Bob Howdyshell reported they held a Fall Series and that their Board of Directors were installed the last Sunday in November.

OYC: Commodore Mark Mallaby stated OYC is following the rules, they raced in the Hot Rum Series; thanking SDYC for the race and SWYC for hosting him and his boat. They nominated their Junior Sailing program for the Junior Program Horder award solicited by SCYA. Vice Commodore Ira Hecht reported they are providing takeout dining as well.

SDYC: Rear Commodore Jeff Tatter reported that they completed the Hot Rum Regatta and that they had a successful fund raising event for military families which raised 80,000 dollars for them.

SGYC: Commodore Lisa Clements reported they have a member, Lee Johnson, single handed sailed to Hawaii in 21 days and he will be gone a year while sailing to destination yet unknown. SGYC is also takeout only for food and also have heat and serve meal options.

SWYC: Commodore Steve Frailey noted that this year has been a struggle but enjoys the SDAYC meeting opportunity to share with other clubs. They are also providing takeout meals and looking for ways to provide more services within COVID guidelines

CRA: Commodore Suzie Graff reported they are racing and they voted their annual Sportsmanship Awards to four different members. She also expressed her appreciation for SDAYC and Collen Cooke for their work to open racing up to non-household members this year.

PLYC: Commodore Jamie Anderson stated they had a rough year but they did conduct a few races. He invited all clubs to stop by for Sunday barbeques and he looks forward to next year. He recognized PC Michael Kirkgestner for his hard work.

SMYC: Junior Director Murtland noted that Kat Wacker would be the Commodore next year and was not present; probably dealing with the loss or her partner.

SDCA: Treasurer Bob Ehlers stated they are ready to conduct predicted log racing next year. He was asked about observers during COVID restricitions and noted they record the predicted log races.

Sandra Sherman, one of the recipients, let the group no of others that had assisted in the rescue.
- f. As a follow up SCYSA's Commodore, John Marshall, announced they are giving their sportsmanship award to the Crew of Sea Maiden as well.

Commodore Poltorak provided comments about his tenure, thanking his board and acknowledging the work they had done as well as his pleasure meeting with SDAYC regularly.
