Ensigns at the Indian Summer Regatta By Bruce Blackie

As the only fleet to enter five or more boats, the Ensign fleet was given a separate start in the Indian Summer Regatta, and the seven competing Ensigns enjoyed a mini Ensign regatta. The warm weather was certainly unique for the fall regatta and was of course accompanied by light and variable winds. However, the race committee was successful in getting in one full race on both Saturday and Sunday. On Saturday, Al and Mary Jean Tedrow with son David made the correct call on several of the major shifts and finished in first place. They were closely followed by co-owners Tony Cannone and Fred Barker with brother Frank Cannone as crew for the second position spot. Bruce Blackie and new member and recent Ensign purchaser Chester Brearev depended on their spinnaker to edge out Emmett McCarthy and crew Katie Hall for third place as the breeze died on a downwind finish.

Sunday conditions were more of the same which meant that everyone was still in the hunt. Bruce Blackie and Chester Brearey again used their spinnaker to take full advantage of the two downwind legs of the I-2 course. After rounding the final leeward mark with a relatively comfortable lead and only a short windward beat to the finish line, Bruce and Chester had one of those it's-never-over-till-it's-over moments when the genoa sheets became entangled with the recently doused spinnaker. After a somewhat controlled fire drill things got sorted out and they finished in first place but the gap had closed considerably. They were able to watch as Jim Ferris and Garret Hamlin with Susan Shipherd and Peter Hamlin on board nipped Al and Mary Jean Tedrow at the finish line after a close one on one competition.

The result was that Bruce and Al were tied with identical scores of first and third and four total points. However the first place regatta position went to Bruce based on the US Sailing protocol. Students of the game can check the Racing Rules of Sailing Appendix A8. With Al in second place, third place went to Tony and Fred with 6 points and one point ahead of Jim and Garret. Jim and Garret's second place finish in the Sunday race moved them 2 points ahead of Emmett McCarthy in the regatta. Dave Miller and Carmelo Kona had a tie with 6 and 7 finishes and thirteen points In this case, Dave was the beneficiary of the US Sailing rules.

Our thanks go to the all the race committee for extracting two credible races from the marginal conditions. It was also a pleasure to see several Ensign spinnakers brightening up the course. All the participants vowed to return next year.
