Our property tax appeal is finally settled – at least until the 2017 tax year. We received a check for \$5995.94 from our attorney, which represents our refund of \$7660.38 for School Taxes paid for the 2013/2104 and 2014/2015 school years, and Town & County Tax paid for 2014, less our attorney's one-time fee of \$1268.52 and \$395.92 for his out of pocket expenses.

I want to thank everyone who helped with the Fall Work Party; and those members who could not participate, but made arrangements to help on alternate dates. We are well positioned for the coming winter, and will be able to quickly get the Club up and running in the Spring of 2015.

I want to invite everyone to attend the Annual Membership Meeting on Sunday, December 7, 2014, starting at 3:00 pm. In addition to the normal reports of the officers, election of officers for 2015, good food and companionship, we plan to have some discussions of changes to make the Club more efficient in various ways. These potential changes include a reorganization of board boat storage on the lower lawn, a plan to experiment with slips for larger boats that are normally moored, and changes to the Club House we are making to reduce energy consumption.



I would like to thank all of those that helped at the fall work party and for the 14 members that worked the following weekend. This year we were able to spread several loads of gravel into the boat yard along the turn near the barn. Tom Kilcer donated matting to put under the stone. We also got one load into the meadow. The geese fence was removed and stored. The barn was fitted to store 9 sail school boats. The canopy was stored until spring and the usual raking and cleanup was completed. Several trees were removed in the dingy area to improve safety and access.

During the second weekend we were able to rotate two of the kayak racks. You will notice that the racks face each other with an aisle between them. The middle rack is to have boats on dollies backed up to it. This will eliminate having boats stored in front of boats on the racks, making it easier for you to use your kayak or canoe. There will be a new rack built for spring facing the playground. For those of you with storage boxes, I will be proposing a plan for them between the trees that are between the racks. If you had a kayak or canoe on the racks, it has most likely been moved and drained.



In the coming weeks the barn roof will have the valleys repair. The valleys are current rusted through. In order to address the safe use of the main ramp, we have installed a d-ring and 4 to 1 block and tackle at the top of the main ramp. The block and tackle is stored in the race shed. You will need to add a line to your trailer. This will get you to dry land and avoid the slick concrete. This is a trial and I am sure it will be modified as we gain experience using it.
