SLSC House & Grounds Clean-Up Check List

- Check and, if necessary, replace all toilet paper and paper towel in the house.

- Vacuum or shake out runner rugs at North and South doors.
- Secure beer cooler and, if empty, clean beer cooler and hoses.
- Remove all regatta food from refrigerator unless it is designated for consumption at Manning pot-luck racing.
- Scan house and grounds for items guests may have left behind.
