- · All YC's will be assigned a launching location and kept together:
- o Fontana (14 X's) Dry sail from Fontana boat launch, Gordy's/Boathouse restrooms available
- o Williams Bay (20 X's) Launch Sunday evening or Monday morning w/ mooring/anchoring off of Edgewater Park Sunday and Monday (BYO Mooring). Private use of Williams Bay Police Dept. launch and Café Calamari parking lot for vehicle/trailer storage
- o South Shore Club (15 X's, launch Sunday from LGYC)
- o Launch assignments/locations by sailor and club, along with detailed maps of each location, will be issued after registration.
- No food will be provided or served.
- o Lunch break will be on the water with time for teams to run to use restrooms as needed
