Delavan YC mourns the passing of Alan Buzzell this morning. Not sure there was anyone prouder to be an ILYA member. Buzzell never missed an ILYA Winter Inland - even though his sight was failing and he could no longer drive. He would convince another Delavan member this was an event not to be missed. Many of you enjoyed hors d'oeuvres due to Buzzell. He is pictured here PROUDLY donning his ILYA RC jacket which he wore every winter. He served during the Kate Goes era as an ILYA race official.

Alan loved scow sailing and also the history of his beloved Delavan. He was Commodore of Delavan in the '80s. His photos are prominent in their Centennial booklet and the editor was gifted with copies of many of the photos of early scow sailing in SE WI. This man truly loved his involvement in sailing.

Unbeknownst perhaps to many of you was his love for the Delavan Fire Department. He served in his latter years as an ambassador to the Safe House project. There was rarely a family with young children who was not invited to visit the educational project if the house were on display.

Lastly, Buzzell was a veteran. He continued his involvement with the American Legion until his final move from his Delavan home.



Walter Schwarting, "Salty" passed away this morning. What a legend he was! Red, red, red! Pins, stickers, balloons- promotion of fun was his mantra. His gregarious nature made him a favorite with all ages. He was quick to take youth as a crew and continued his love of youth by attending all nearby regattas later in life. Salty continued to serve as a judge for the WYA right up to the end. The last WYA C regatta on LaBelle, Salty and buddy Dick Keck were there - down the street from their retirement home residences - enjoying the camaraderie only known amongst sailors. No sooner had he appeared and a crowd gathered for Salty stories.

Salty was a fine, fine sailor winning numerous C and MC Championships. He served as a WYA Commodore 1982-84. He moved from his lifelong love of the C scow to an MC as he aged. If there were a title of Road Warrior for lifelong participation, Salty would be right at the top.

Salty's presence will remain on the water with relatives carrying the V-10 number and the Wally's Warriors name on the boat. That spirit will live on.

Salty's wife Mary Jo was always by his side. He precedes her in death.
