It's Silver for Roble - Shea at Kiel Week

In tough conditions, some reported as SURVIVAL, Stephanie Roble and Maggie Shea returned to competition for the first time since February. Coronavirus shut down all Olympic training for a period as mandated by US Sailing and then travel restrictions put the American's hopes on hold. They traveled to Europe where they have been training at Lake Garda with their Italian coach, Giulia Conte. Laser and 49er Olympic contenders from the US also traveled to Europe to train.

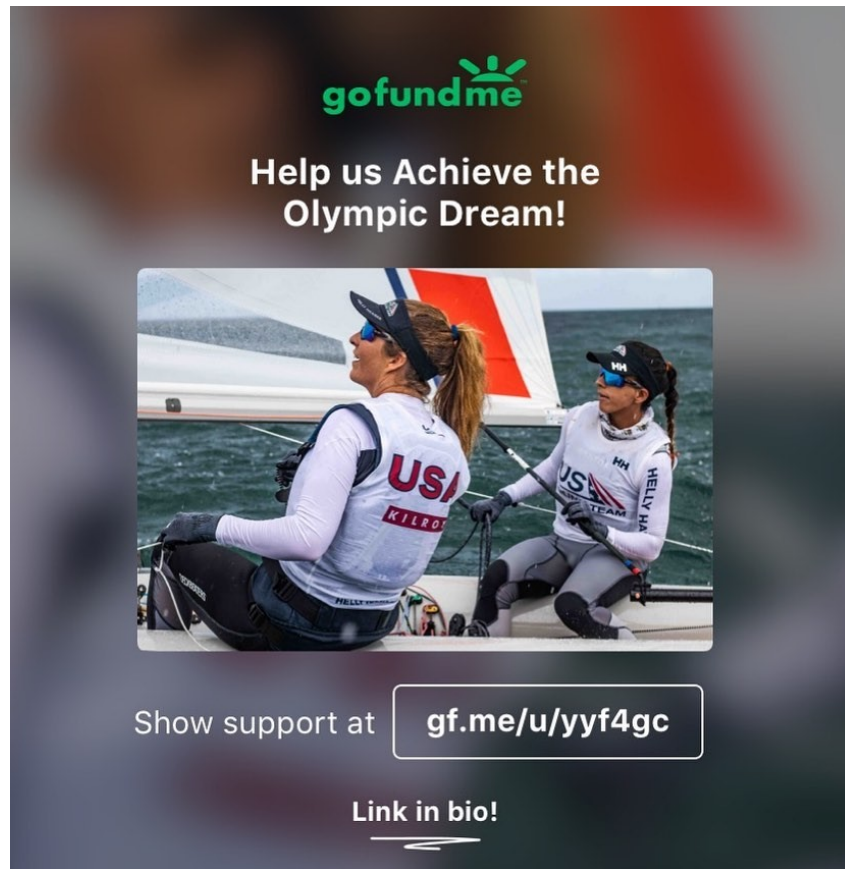
The four-day event resulted in a silver medal for the duo. [Results](#) indicate only one finish not in the top ten. Turns out consistency is key. With one stellar day on Saturday of 1-2-1-6, they placed themselves in good position but the points were tight. A last minute last race maneuver at the finish for 10th place (yes, every inch is fought for) resulted in the silver medal. Competition was tight - even for 10th place.



The team's new black spinnaker sports an LBYC logo due to a socially-distanced fundraiser on Lake Beulah where \$40,000 was raised to allow them to reside in Europe for a minimum three months to train. 50+ boats were on the line which would not occur in the US at this time. The additional year has caused the US teams to require aggressive fundraising to continue.
