College Sailing Webinar - Thursday, June 4 7:00 PM

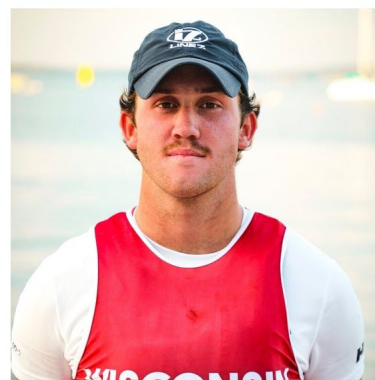

In each of the four sessions they go on a 'deep-dive' to examine the meaning and tactical implications of one particular right-of-way rule. The topics we'll cover are: Port-Starboard (Rule 10); Avoiding Contact (Rule 14); Changing Course (Rule 16); and Proper Course (Rule 17)

Each session is about 80 minutes long with video, diagrams, quizzes and references to appeals and cases. 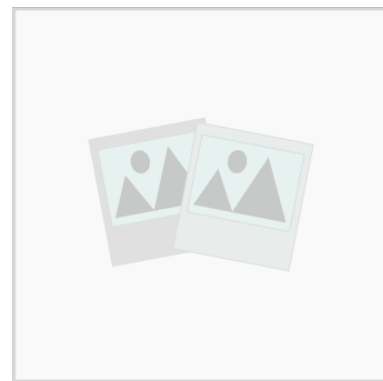
