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## Regatta Results from Florida

### Valentine's Day Regatta - St. Petersburg, FL

A special congratulations to Madison's Sophie Niemann, Lake Forest's Avery Keane, Geneva's Kai-Suh Pomierski and Pewaukee's Jack Goggins for placing in the top 25 of 89 in the Silver Fleet. In the Gold Fleet, Geneva's Will Platten was top Midwesterner followed by Chicago's Annie Samis, Pewaukee's John Lieber and Beulah's Alex Mueller in the top 50 of 189.

# ILYA is accepting bids for 2022

It might seem a bit early but the Spring ILYA Board of Directors meeting will discuss bids for the 2022 season. [The bid process includes the completion of the form](#) found on the website. In addition, notifying your fleet representative is always helpful to address any specific needs you or the fleet might desire for that year: i.e. this is our 100th year, we are trying to build a fleet, the fleet wants to run windward legs of 2 miles (not really but there may be some unusual conditions the fleet wants). The Regatta Coordinating Committee reviews all applications, asks additional questions and then weighs the wishes of the fleet, the distribution geographically to gain balance, considers special requests, etc before recommending the awarding of the regatta.

Here is the bid sheet as it currently stands. You can see clubs bid for multiple years knowing the final selection is based on more than the club's assets. Some events/classes have geographical rotations.
