Why I'm Eager to Serve as Your National Secretary

In my opinion, Snipes are the premiere double-handed boats to sail in the United States and I believe that we are extremely well positioned to grow as a class when compared to other sailing options. I intend to help "move the needle" to ensure that the US Snipe Class remains a prominent figure in one design racing for many generations to come. I plan to enable the US Snipe class to sustain growth through active, demographically diverse sailors participating in local, regional and international Snipe class sailing activities, supported by a financially sound national organization.

To achieve this vision, I plan to implement a volunteer led strategy around three main initiatives:

- 1. Prioritize the **fiduciary and governance responsibilities** of the SCIRA US Board to enable long term support of Snipe sailors in the US and their eligibility for international competition by an increased focus on fundraising and financial efficiency.
- 2. Increase Snipe Class **sailing activities and participation** throughout the US by propagating what we've seen work in high-growth fleets to other fleets across the country.
- 3. Build a **sustainable membership base** around the US with enhanced focus on Women's and NextGen (post-collegiate, young professional, U30) snipe sailing by defining and communicating the value of SCIRA membership along with scheduling SCIRA USA backed Women's and NextGen challenges across the country.
