It has come to my barn for rehab this winter from Marblehead.

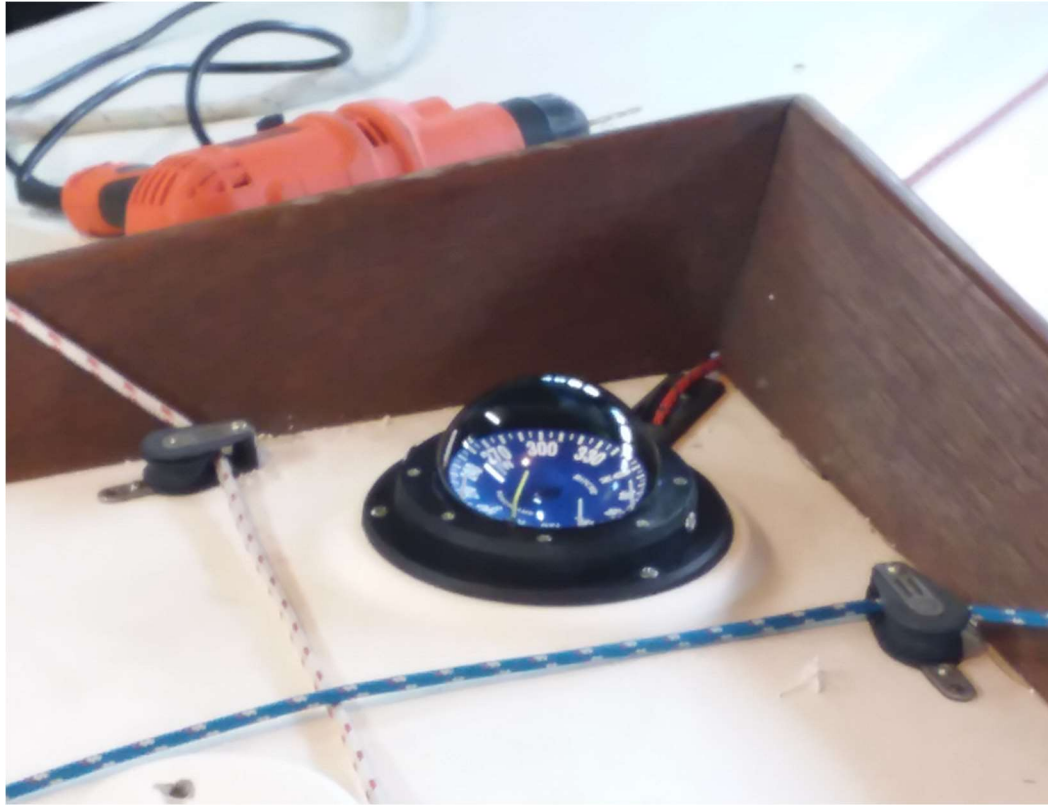
\$2500 complete with trailer and 2 sets of sails and intensions are for it to be sold to a current or future club member.

Trailer has been painted, bunks have been re-carpeted, safety chain painted, bearings inspected and greased.



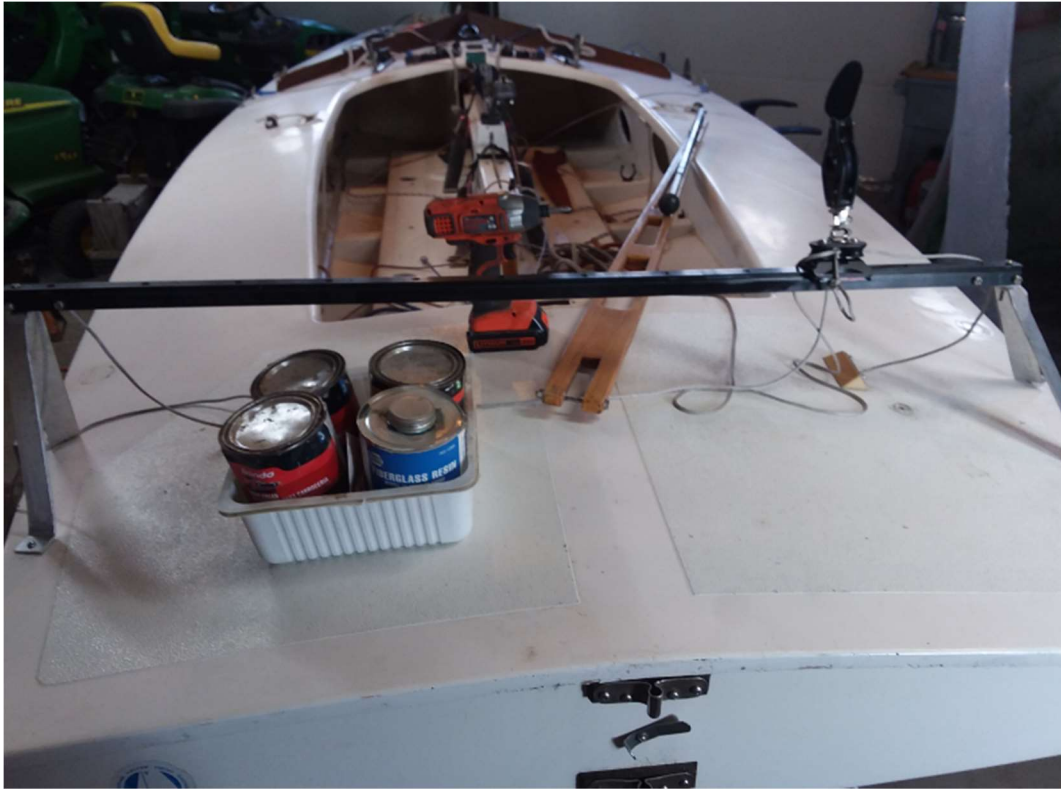
New Ritchie RU-90 Voyager racing compass installed:
