Commodore's Message

Dear ILYA Enthusiasts,

In April I began a two-year term as Commodore of the ILYA. I am humbled and honored by the appointment. My primary goal during my term is to GROW THE SPORT. Your ILYA Board has worked hard to identify several areas which will make our organization stronger, and we have developed and adopted the first ever Strategic Plan for this organization at our Fall meeting. We intend this to be a "living document" with frequent updating as our world evolves and changes.

This is not your grandfather's ILYA. In 2020 it is an organization, that while still holding true to our traditional values, is concurrently striving to be more forward thinking and relevant. We all have decisions to make on where to spend your dollars and most importantly our time and our family time. We want to provide a fun, exciting competitive sailing experience that you can't afford to miss.

Our new ILYA Strategic Plan has six areas of focus:

1. Provide High-quality regattas to Members
2. Strengthen ILYA promotion and communication
3. Increase Value to all of our stakeholders – Members, member Yacht Clubs, and Sailing Schools.
4. Maximize Sailor, Race Committee and Regatta Organizer performance through training and education
5. Ensure the short and long-term financial stability of the ILYA
6. Streamline our Board and Committee Structure

The Board and Executive Committee cannot achieve these goals alone. We want you to become involved. What is your passion and expertise? How can you support our efforts to move this organization forward? Each area of focus will have a project-based task force set up to these strategic goals.

We would love to recruit some of our members to serve on our task forces. We have current needs in both Promotions and Finance.

- As you are well aware, the age of social media has changed the way we advertise, promote and execute our events. We're looking for some marketing/communications champions who can jump on board and provide new and fresh ideas for social media, website, apps and other forms of communication for our members of all ages. Perhaps you might want to be involved with a single event, or maybe you want to help organize across multiple events throughout the summer. You could be a college student looking to get experience while you study marketing, or you might be an industry veteran – we welcome all viewpoints.
- We're also looking for members for our Finance Task Force that would be willing to leverage their business skills in the areas of budgeting, financial analysis, reporting and data mining. We have decades of data regarding our regatta attendance, the cost thereof and annual P&L. We want to use this data to make us more efficient and streamlined. Again, this is a great opportunity for anyone studying business or accounting to get involved.

We know that our committee approach can yield positive results. A little over a year ago Coye Harrett from Minnetonka took over the Regatta Coordinating Committee (RCC). Prior to the formation of this committee the regatta awarding process was not nearly as sophisticated as it is today. We are still refining and improving our process; however, now when clubs submit a regatta bid, they use an online form which has been developed to take many factors into account. These factors are weighted, and a thoughtful, consistent awarding

My main goals over the remainder of my term are to ensure that we are providing real value to members and member Clubs/Schools. We are currently having conversations about our membership levels and the benefits associated with those different price points. It seems that many of our members only join when they are going to sail in an ILYA regatta. What can we do to entice non-regatta sailors join and support the work of the ILYA on a regular basis?

Another initiative is that of Youth Sailing. Chris Allen has recently taken over this committee and has some exciting ideas of what we can do to promote education for our youth sailors. Our Opti and X Boat sailors are the future of the ILYA. How can we educate them today to make them better sailors? What can we do to ensure that they continue on after they leave the youth fleets?

My final message to you centers on Member Club Delegates. Every ILYA Member Club has an assigned "Delegate to the ILYA". At our Spring Meeting each year our By-Laws require certain items to be voted on by the Delegates. We need to use the knowledge and expertise of the Delegates for more than just a vote in March/April. They should be the live-link between the ILYA and each of its Member Clubs. We're working on a way to keep ILYA Delegates in the loop and vice versa. What can we do for you and your Club? What are you and your Club doing to promote the ILYA? How can we be stronger together? There will soon be a tab on our website with all of the Club Delegates names and member Clubs so you will know who to reach out to locally. The ILYA is strong but could be so much stronger with more Delegate involvement.

In closing, I'm so excited about the future of the ILYA. This is an organization that certainly is not broken but one that is strong enough to move into the future by enhancing our current structure. I ask for all of your help in accomplishing our goals. I'd also like to say thank you to those ILYA leaders that have come before me. Their hard work and perseverance have set us up to be able to move forward in a very positive manner.

HUSE INLAND LAKE YACHTING ASSOCIATION SPORTSMANSHIP TROPHY

It is with the highest appreciation the ILYA accepts a magnanimous gift in memory of one of its finest gentlemen to grace our waters in scows. The Jerry Huse family has graciously contributed, along with significant contributions from several friends and members of the Okoboji Yacht Club, the *HUSE INLAND LAKE YACHTING ASSOCIATION SPORTSMANSHIP TROPHY*.

Jerry Huse was a past Commodore and member of the board of directors of both the Inland Lake Yachting Association and the Okoboji Yacht Club. His leadership left an indelible impression on these organizations and its members. Jerry, over the course of a 70+ year racing career, was a four-time Inland champion in the C Scow Class, a past ILYA Commodore and is a member of the ILYA Bilge Pullers Hall of Fame.

Jerry is remembered as a man of energy and commitment to excellence not only in his own racing but also helping everyone become a better sailor. He provided the ILYA with tremendous examples of Sportsmanship by his approach to competition through encouragement, active service to others, and his coaching. A man of civic prominence and achievement as well, Jerry was friend to all.

Huse Sportsmanship Trophy Selection Criteria

Established in 2019 by friends and family of Jerry Huse, the Huse Inland Lake Yachting Association Sportsmanship Award shall be presented annually to the person who best exemplifies the ideals of sportsmanship in competitive sailboat racing within the Inland Lake Yachting Association.

- The individual recognized with the Huse Sportsmanship Award will be a person who has pursued or supported the sport of competitive sailboat racing together with the highest regard for others including competitors and the race committee. Respectful adherence to the racing rules, and their spirit, will be an important consideration along with exhibiting compassion for all.
- The recipient may be an ILYA sailor (skipper or crew), and is not restricted solely to sportsmanship displayed at ILYA Championship events and other ILYA regattas.
- Nominations may be made by ILYA members or member clubs, and all are encouraged to do so. Nominees need not have sailed any ILYA regattas in that year. It is expected that the award recipient is a member of the ILYA at the time of the award.
- Selection is made by a committee appointed by the ILYA Commodore and may include ad-hoc members of the Huse family or Okoboji Yacht Club.

Trophy

The Huse Trophy is a beautiful creation marking the memory of Jerry with a custom base featuring International Orange hints around the recipient plates - the Orange hints are to align with the C scow deck color of P-1. The trophy was created in 1896 by Gorham

Todd Haines representing the ILYA, and Beth Huse Olsen representing the Okoboji Yacht Club, presented Gloria Melges the ILYA Huse Sportsmanship Trophy as its inaugural recipient. With a standing ovation, the gracious Gloria addressed the crowd giving husband Buddy a few little playful verbal nudges, but expressed her appreciation for such an honor. Her love for the Huse family was evident as she recalled the qualities of the trophy's namesake which make this award so unique. (Read [here](#) about the genesis of the Huse Trophy)

Dr. John DeCarlo, LGYC Commodore welcomed all to this special evening. The honor of bestowing this award to his friend was evident. Dr. Tom Hodgson reviewed the efforts of Gloria over 50 years. Lastly, Buddy could not resist proudly telling the crowd of Gloria's beauty, keen eye on the water, ability to analyze and coach him at the highest level. Her innate understanding of the tactics on the boat and on the water makes no one wonder how her prodigy fare so exceptionally in our sport.

The evening was magical in many ways. Gloria is from a time past with a poise and tender manner. The room was aglow with admirers. Her peers were there to celebrate the award. Youth were present to honor her. The intergenerational composition of the attendees exemplified the respect all hold for Gloria Melges. Congratulations to our first Huse Sportsmanship recipient. 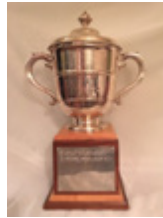

The Edmund Pillsbury Memorial Cup

In August 1952, Mr. and Mrs. John S. Pillsbury and family in memory of Edmund Pillsbury presented to the Inland Lake Yachting Association a trophy to be known as "The Edmund Pillsbury Memorial Cup" to be awarded annually to the skipper of the yacht, irrespective of class, who makes the outstanding record in the annual Inland Lake Yachting Association Regatta.

With the permission of the Pillsbury family it was decided in 1965 to award this trophy in the future to the outstanding skipper at the annual regatta, selection to be made by an anonymous committee of Directors appointed by the Commodore.

The Okoboji Yacht Club has enjoyed a very long history. The first yacht club was organized in 1877. A series of races were held over the next few years, but interest declined by the late 1880's and the club ceased to exist. The turn of the century brought a new interest in sailing, and yachting again came to the top of the sporting list.

In 1897, a new yacht club was formed with forty to fifty members. This group took over the dining hall and clubhouse on Pike's Point around 1906. The Okoboji Yacht Club became a fashionable spot to gather for dancing, dining, bathing and billiards. Boats of all sizes and varieties were sailed. The first annual meeting of the OYC was held at this clubhouse on August 3, 1908. With the coming of the automobile and lake roads, the club again folded up about 1911.

The next chapter for the Okoboji Yacht Club began with an impromptu meeting at Nita Seeman's cottage on McHenry's Point (Givens Point near Okoboji Boat Works) in July, 1933. The first sailing event was to be held on July 4, 1933. The course was north and west from Fort Dodge Point, then south towards Brown's Bay, then back to Pillsbury Point. Preliminary races were held July 1 to set handicaps for the many varieties of sailboats. At this time, there were three classes of boats; the small moth sailboats, the catboat class, and the gaff rigged "C" class. By 1934, the OYC was holding a Sunday series of races and providing Inland Lake Yachting Association rule books to the skippers. Gene Huse, of Norfolk, Nebraska, donated the rule books for the 25 club members.

In 1935, the yacht club had moved their headquarters to the Gull Point State Park Lodge. Communicating to the fleet as to whether or not there would be races for the day was a problem for the early yacht club. They didn't have the handheld marine radios that are used today. In 1934, to signal that a race was being held, a huge bomb, donated by Hubert Everist of Sioux City, Iowa, was set off on Fort Dodge Point. The following year, 1935, the yacht club erected a thirty foot tall flag pole on Gull Point. A white flag hoisted meant races were on; a red flag hoisted indicated a storm was coming.

During World War II, 1945, the Okoboji Yacht Club was mostly made up of girls and young women and was called the Okoboji Women's Navy. They held races on Wednesdays at 5:00 pm, Saturdays at 2:00 pm and Sundays at 10:30 with special races for Father's Day and the Fourth of July.



In August, 1957, a permanent clubhouse was built, lakeside, next to the New Inn on Dixon's Beach. It was only 40 x 60 foot with a 10 x 20 foot porch. Classes of sailboats raced were the E, C, Y and X boats. Later, in the the 1960's, M-16's and M-20's were also raced. In 1982, when the yacht club moved to its present location on South Manhattan Beach, it sold the old clubhouse to Bill Sackett who moved it to a lot across from his home on Hayward's Bay.

The current Okoboji Yacht Club, located on South Manhattan Beach, is the fourth yachting club on the lake. The yacht club leases the facility from the Okoboji Sailing School. Construction started on the current sailing facility in September, 1997 and was completed in June, 1998. A pledge drive was initiated in 1997 to raise the funds to cover construction of the facility. It was very successful, raising over one million dollars in pledges. A year later, Lee Seeman made an additional pledge of one million dollars to establish an endowment fund for the operation of the Okoboji Yacht Club Sailing School.

Today's Okoboji Yacht Club has about 500 members and 65 registered sailboats. It hosts five classes of boats, the X, MC, C, Yngling and E boats. Club races are conducted on Saturday and Sunday mornings from Memorial Day through Labor Day. The OYC hosts a variety of social events for sailors and non-sailors. The Friday Nite Socials are a popular gathering time and the club hosts a large yacht club party once a month during June, July and August. Bridge and mahjong groups also meet at the clubhouse on a weekly basis.
