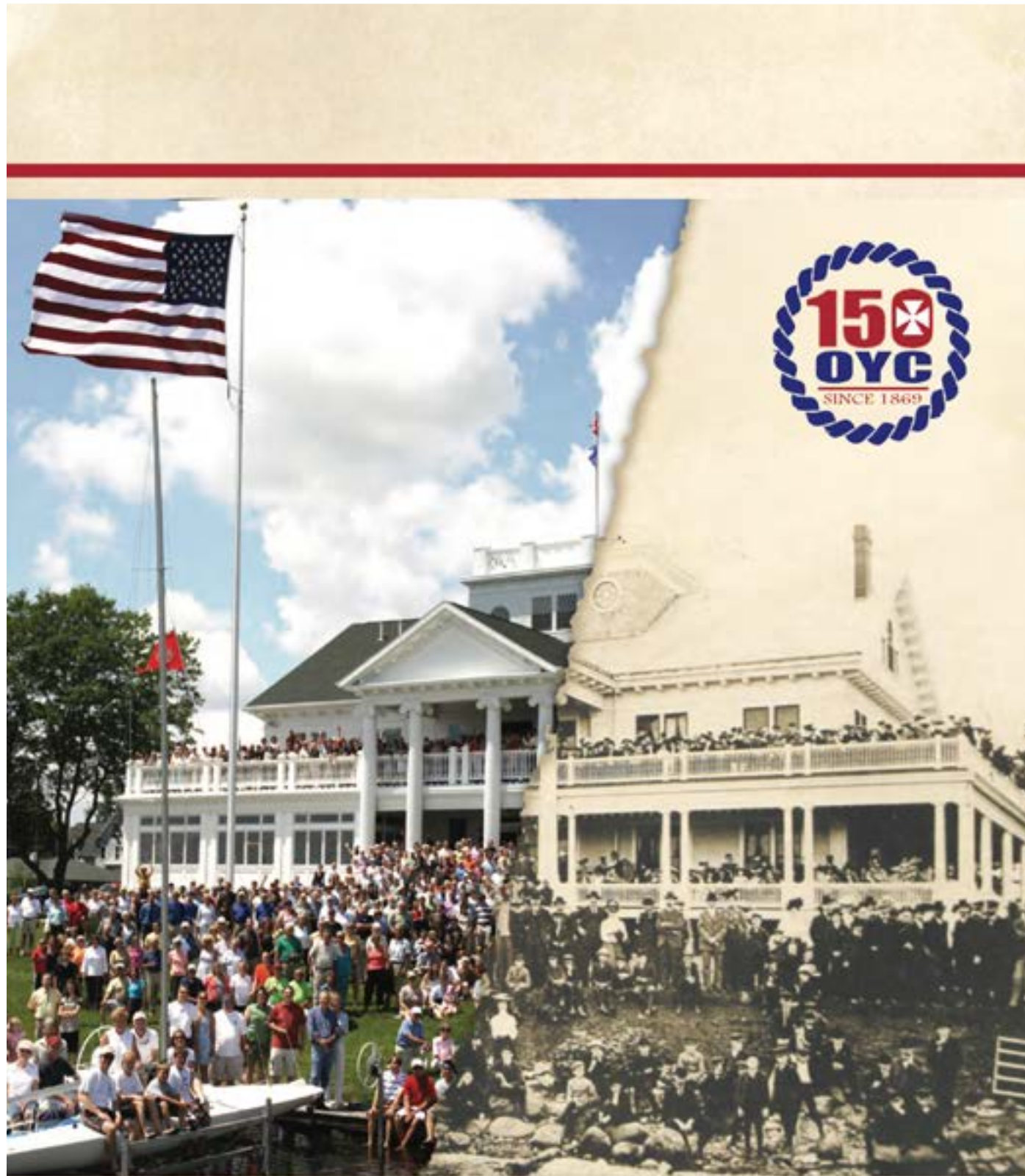

WAIVER OF LIABILITY: I recognize and understand that participation in the regatta is voluntary, and that my child incurs risks by participating, including the possibility of death or injury. In consideration of the acceptance of my child's entry, I waive any and all claims, charges, losses and liabilities including those caused by negligence, against the Inland Lake Yachting Association and its host clubs, their respective officers, trustees, contractors, employees, and members, and against any and all volunteers, which may arise from, or in any way be in connection with, the practices or activities of the regatta and its organizers. I am aware that the activities of my child may involve maneuvering a boat on deep waters in potentially hazardous conditions which may include among other things, cold water temperature, strong winds and high waves, sudden and unexpected immersion in deep waters and collision with other watercraft or stationary objects such as docks, pilings, and buoys. I understand that I am responsible for the actions of my child while he or she may be participating in the regatta and on the grounds of the event host, and that I am solely responsible for deciding whether or not my child participates or continues participating in the event. We also agree that the sailor will be bound by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the rules of ILYA and by all other rules that govern this event.

Media Rights Statement for all Youth Events

Competitors' parents or guardians give absolute right and permission for video footage or photographs of competitors or their boats generated during an ILYA event to be published in any media for press, editorial or advertising purposes.

Risks

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor, or in the case of minors, each competitor's parent or guardian, agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

Roble/Shea Sailing USA

Roble/Shea Sailing USA is sending you this update from Lake Garda, Italy, where we are training with several international FX teams in between regattas. These training camps give us the opportunity to work on specific goals and also race against the other teams. The camps are very productive because we can set our objectives for the day based on the forecast. The training we are able to do outside of a regatta is invaluable and we are grateful to our coach, Giulia Conti, for organizing this camp.

So far in 2019 Roble/Shea Sailing has:

- Earned our first World Cup Series medals
- Bronze in Genoa, Italy
- Qualified to represent Team USA at the Pan American Games in Peru
- Qualified to represent the US Sailing Team at the Olympic Test Event in Japan
- Sailed in every Medal Race (top 10) of the 2019 World Cup Series
- #1 ranked 49erFX team on the US Sailing Team and #12 in the World Rankings

The Pan American Games in Paracas, Peru, will be our opportunity to qualify the United States for a berth at the Olympics. Then we will travel straight to Japan to kick off the US Trials (to determine which team will go to the Olympics) with the Olympic Test Event and World Cup Series Japan – both on the Olympic waters of Enoshima. Our year will conclude with a few more trips across the Pacific to train for, and then compete in, the 49erFX World Championship in Auckland, New Zealand.



This Olympic path is full of ups and downs and we are so grateful for the support of the ILYA. Having amazing hometown support makes each day better and we could not be doing what we do without that support! Thank you all so much!

From the pages of ScowLines...

European Tour Part III

We spent the last 31 days in Northern Europe training and racing with some of the best sailors on the planet. We started our trip Scheveningen, Netherlands, where we spent 17 days training with the Dutch 49er team. We then spent our remaining time in Kiel, Germany preparing for one of the worlds biggest regatta's, Kieler Woche.

What We Were Up To.

We started our trip in Scheveningen, Ned, doing 17 days of training with the Dutch national 49er team. Us and two other US 49er teams were fortunate enough to be invited to use the Dutch National Sailing Facilities while we got into the nitty-gritty of a training camp. All in all the Netherlands was a very cool experience because of we now have made many life long friends from the Netherlands. This camp focused on approaching the windward mark in a cleaner fashion and being able to successfully be able to execute boat handling under pressure. I am happy to say that we have made big steps in our overall racing program over the last month. We have gotten better at sailing cleanly around the track, we are tacking and gybing faster than we ever have before, and we are also going faster than we ever have before. In our eyes, Holland was a huge success when it comes to climbing up the never ending learning curve.

The second half of our trip was spent preparing for the Kieler Woche regatta in Kiel, Germany. We did ten days of training and racing in beautiful conditions. Finn and I felt at home while in Germany, we mostly had offshore winds, which meant it was flat water, shifty, and puffy, just like home! We also were staying out in the "stick's" surrounded by horses and corn fields, just like home. Another bonus to Kiel was my family's history, not only is my heritage from Northern Germany but my grandfather won a gold medal on the waters of Kiel, as you can see in the photo below. With all of the variables such as feeling very confident in the venue, knowing that we were sailing better than we ever have, you would think that the regatta would go well, and it did. We were very pleased to finish our European season with the best result ever in the 49er. We ended up missing the gold fleet by three points because of a silly capsized, but we still sailed incredibly well. We finished 30th out of 87 boats, and we were the second best US 49er by just one boat.

Whats Next?

At the moment we are on our way home for a 5 day rest period and then we will be traveling to Long Beach, California for 2 weeks of training! During the month of July we have to fundraisers, one in Lake Geneva on July 12th, and another meeting in Bay Head, New Jersey on July 19th.

It is with the highest appreciation the ILYA accepts a magnanimous gift in memory of one of its finest gentlemen to grace our waters in scows.

The Jerry Huse family has graciously contributed, along with significant contributions from several friends and members of the Okoboji Yacht Club, the **HUSE INLAND LAKE YACHTING ASSOCIATION SPORTSMANSHIP TROPHY**.

Jerry Huse was a past Commodore and member of the board of directors of both the Inland Lake Yachting Association and the Okoboji Yacht Club. His leadership left an indelible impression on these organizations and its members. Jerry, over a 70+ year racing career, was a four-time Inland champion in the C Scow Class, a past ILYA Commodore and is a member of the ILYA Bilge Pullers Hall of Fame.

Jerry is remembered as a man of energy and commitment to excellence not only in his own racing but also helping everyone become a better sailor. He provided the ILYA with tremendous examples of Sportsmanship by his approach to competition through encouragement, active service to others, and his coaching. A man of civic prominence and achievement as well, Jerry was friend to all.

Huse Sportsmanship Trophy Selection Criteria

Established in 2019 by friends and family of Jerry Huse, the Huse Inland Lake Yachting Association Sportsmanship Award shall be presented annually to the person who best exemplifies the ideals of sportsmanship in competitive sailboat racing within the Inland Lake Yachting Association.

The individual recognized with the Huse Sportsmanship Award will be a person who has pursued or supported the sport of competitive sailboat racing together with the highest regard for others including competitors and the race committee. Respectful adherence to the racing rules, and their spirit, will be an important consideration along with exhibiting compassion for all.

The recipient may be an ILYA sailor (skipper or crew), and is not restricted solely to sportsmanship displayed at ILYA Championship events and other ILYA regattas.

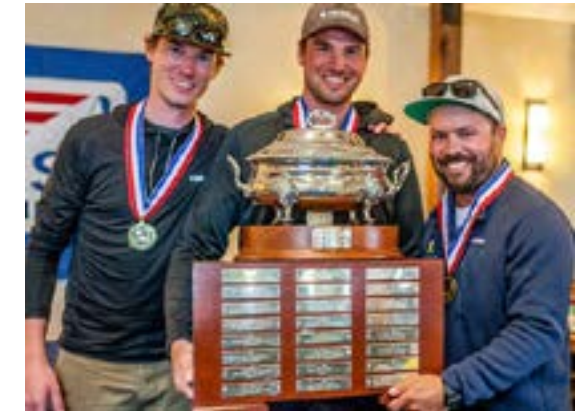
Nominations may be made by ILYA members or member clubs, and all are encouraged to do so. Nominees need not have sailed any ILYA regattas in that year. It is expected that the award recipient is a member of the ILYA at the time of the award.

Selection is made by a committee appointed by the ILYA Commodore and may include ad-hoc members of the Huse family or Okoboji Yacht Club.

Trophy

The Huse Trophy is a beautiful creation marking the memory of Jerry with a custom base featuring International Orange hints around the recipient plates - the Orange hints are to align with the C scow deck color of P-1. The trophy was created in 1896 by Gorham in Providence, Rhode Island.

The ILYA is looking forward to nominations and first presenting the award in late Fall 2019. In the meantime, the trophy will be on display at Okoboji YC as its members celebrate and reflect on Jerry's legacy.



ILYA Team lead by Mike Hanson wins the Mallory Cup - from the pages of Scowlines

Published on September 29th, 2018 from US Sailing

Michael Hanson (Wayzata, Minn.) and crew turned a 56-year drought on its ear when they won the 63rd U.S. Adult Sailing Championship, held September 26-29 in Wayzata, MN. They didn't just turn it on its ear, they ran it over, back and forth. Hanson, Tim Siemers (Maple Grove, Minn.) and Mark Swift (St. Paul, Minn.) dominated the regatta on Lake Minnetonka, posting the low score of 53 points to win the coveted Mallory Trophy. Sailed in J/22s, they won six races and finished outside of the top three only three times in 20 races for an incredibly low average score of 2.7.

The Mallory Trophy has a mixed history of close finishes and blowouts. The past two years have been more on the blowout side, with victories by 11 and 13 points, and Hanson continued that trend. His 16-point margin of victory is the largest since a 21-point victory in 2011. Hanson and crew won the first four races and never looked back.

"We had great teamwork all weekend," said Hanson. "Mark on the bow and Tim in the middle were rock solid. It was shifty all weekend so you had to stay in phase.

"Our game plan was to not make any big mistakes," Hanson continued. "We came out guns blazing and won the first four races. We kind of kept the pedal to the metal on Day 2 and then played it a bit more conservatively the last two days. All in all, it was awesome."

The winning trio represented the Inland Lake Yachting Association. As an association of some 51 clubs across 10 states and the District of Columbia, the ILYA won the Mallory Trophy four years in a row, 1959-'62, with the legendary Harry C. "Buddy" Melges, an America's Cup winner and Olympic Gold and Bronze medalist, winning the first three of those titles.

Although the ILYA hasn't won since '62, 28 years before the 28-year-old Hanson was born, he wanted to represent the ILYA to stem that drought. Hanson was "well aware" of the ILYA's history and in particular Melges' victories, whom he views as an idol.

"I've heard stories of Buddy looking back on those victories as a springboard to his career," Hanson said. "He's a bit of an idol in the ILYA and I can only hope that this victory has a similar effect on my career."

Hanson, who grew up sailing scows, is building an impressive résumé. He was part of the winning crew for the 2018 ILYA A Scow Championships and last year sailed aboard a Sydney 38 in the Sydney-Hobart Race where they placed first in Class C under the ORCi rating system and fifth under IRC. He has taught sailing in Australia, California and locally as Race Director at the Lake Minnetonka Sailing School. Now he shares his name on two trophy placards with Melges.

"When I was 14 years old I won an X Boat regatta that he had won," Hanson said of the popular one-design that is raced on lakes. "It's an honor seeing my name on a trophy with his."

The championship regatta was hosted by the Wayzata Yacht Club (Wayzata, MN), just outside the Minneapolis/St. Paul metro area. The race committee ran a total of 22 races, with each of the 11 teams getting two byes in the series. Races were held on a windward/leeward course with the breeze ranging from a low of 6 to 8 knots to a gusty 20 knots.



#FairSailing Phase 2 – Building on

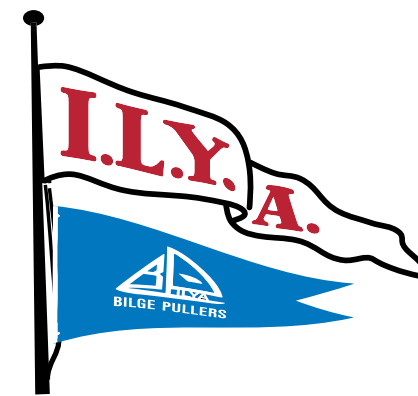

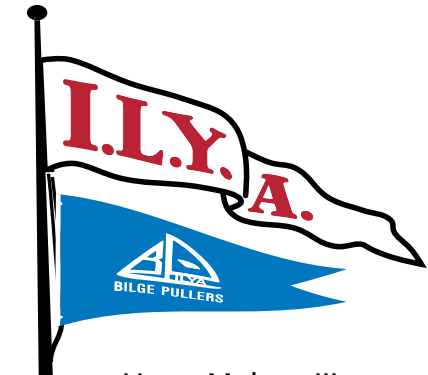

THE OSHKOSH YACHT CLUB

FOUNDED in 1869, is an oshkosh based not-for-profit, tax-exempt 501c3, sailing organization devoted to enjoying the waters of lake winnebago.

The OYC strives to:

- encourage healthy competition with one-design sailing
- support water safety
- promote sportsmanship
- teach the sport of sailing to new members, emphasizing youth sailing and safety
- encourage sailors to find life-long pleasure in the sport, preserve the rich sailing heritage of Oshkosh, and the importance of Oshkosh and Lake Winnebago in the development of scow sailing.

Our social and family members provide a foundation to create a family-friendly atmosphere for the enjoyment of the water.

THE OSHKOSH YACHT CLUB was organized in 1869 when lake schooners and cutters sought to add formality to what had been up to that point informal competition between commercial vessels on the lake. Rules were adopted and a system to handicap yachts was agreed to. Summer regattas were organized with yachts invited to compete from other cities on the lake or other inland lakes. The regattas became the social events of the summer. Much civic pride was demonstrated by area newspapers and those who crowded onto steamboats to witness the competition on Lake Winnebago.

Frank Gates and other members played a part in the development of the racing scow in the late 1890's and into the early 1900's. The OYC is a founding and charter member of the Inland Lake Yachting Association established in August of 1897. The club has continued to sail scows to the present. The classes currently sailing in OYC sanctioned races include Class A, E, 420, X, IOD, and Laser.

In 1903 the city of Oshkosh buzzed with excitement over a crown jewel, the Oshkosh Yacht Club. Designed by the great architect the ILYA Championship Regatta, the magnificent building was erected by area craftsmen in three short months. It opened two days before the start of the 1903 Inland Championship and was regarded as the finest club house to be found in the Midwest. Sailors and their families from throughout the United States came here to enjoy Inland Lake Yachting Association events season after sailing season. When cold autumn winds began to blow, she was closed; awaiting arrival of the next summer and the sailing that would take place.

The building was lost to the city of Oshkosh twice for failure to pay property taxes during periods of wars, waning interest and hard financial times. The city sold it to American Legion Post 70 who owned and maintained the property as their club house until 2007.

During the years when the OYC had no formal home, the Oshkosh Yacht Club used Menominee Park as a hub of operations. In the latter third of the last century, OYC activity returned to the American Legion property, where we have been ever since. We have rented the harbor, used the lawn on sailing days and centered our social activities over the years. In 1997, the club house was used as the center for all night time entertainment during the ILYA Centennial Regatta. A tent erected on the lawn rocked as sailors and their families danced the night away to the tunes of Vince Vance and the Valiants among other bands. Year to year leases

THAT DREAM BECAME A REALITY IN 2008 when the yacht club purchased the the original Yacht Club building and renamed it 'The Waters,' returning it to her original state of grandeur, with all of the modern amenities required of such a building. The Waters primary use will be that of a premiere event facility.

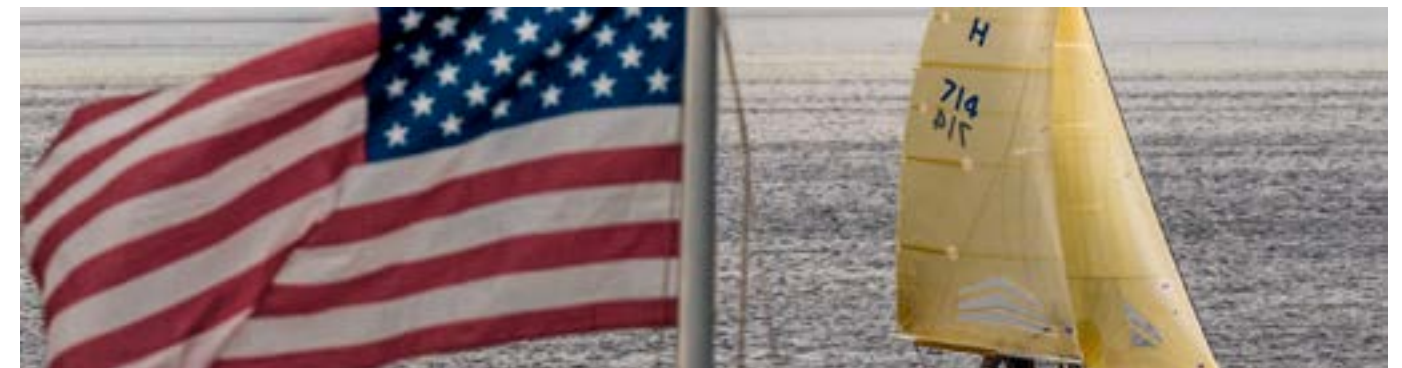
The OYC has signed a very affordable 50-year lease with The Waters for the harbor and the harbor-side terrace where a Sailing Center has been built. A separate 50-year lease was signed, for sailing season use of the Oshkosh Yacht Club, in The Water's lower level's meeting and instructional space. Committees are in place to continue on in the pursuit of our mission of promoting youth sailing and water safety, enhancing our prevalent historical legacy of competitive sailing, keeping sailing affordable for families in the Oshkosh area, and creating a warm home for the OYC family to return to for the next 50 years – being at the core of our endeavor.

The OYC Homecoming Campaign was born to pursue that dream. In 2008 yacht club members and sailing enthusiasts raised the funds necessary to expand the harbor to allow our youth sailing program to move to The Waters from Miller's Bay. The expansion also allows the possibility of social members coming via boat to the club's open hours and social events.

Building on the past to create a bright future. The face of the future is the face of our youth. With our continued emphasis on youth sailing, water safety, and the OYC Sailing School, we grow many sailors. But, perhaps it is more important that we help youth to gain other skills. Youth participation promotes water safety, self-confidence, social skills, sportsmanship, and quick decision-making. When the kids show up to sail, they are 'unplugged,' as MP3 players, Game boys, and cell phones aren't convenient or useful out on the lake. Over 700 youth sailors have been a part of the OYC Sailing School over the last 25 years, and more than 75 adult students have learned to sail through the Sailing School, too.

THE OYC is not a group of haughty blue blazer clad yachtsmen. Members are smattered throughout the Oshkosh area, and represent all socio-economic levels. The common denominator among us is the love of competitive sailing and our beautiful lake. Together, we share with the youth of "Oshkosh on the Water" the many aspects of competitive sailing, respect for the water, safety, and positive social interaction.

THE INLAND LAKE YACHTING ASSOCIATION is the parent organization of the OYC. Their beginnings date back to 1897, when representative from ten Upper Midwest sailing clubs met at White Bear Lake, Minnesota, during an interlake-challenge regatta. The purpose of the meeting was made clear in a resolution passed that afternoon: "to encourage and promote yachting and interlake racing on the inland lakes of the West under uniform rules of measurement, classification, racing and sailing." That purpose is still the same today. Tradition is the key of the ILYA whether it be in the families that have sailed for generations, the local club races or annual championship regattas that have been held since the ILYA origin. The organization has mirrored the changing times but never lost sight of the camaraderie which make the organization so unique. (Taken in part from the History of the ILYA: Tom Hodgson)

The Edmund Pillsbury Memorial Cup
