## **Brian Porter named US Sailing's Rolex Yachtsman of the Year**

Congratulations to ILYA scow sailor and Melges 24 skipper Brian Porter, Lake Geneva, for being named US Sailing's 2013 Rolex Yachtsman of the Year, after an impressive win at the 2013 Melges 24 World Championships, following a win at the 2013 Quantum Key West race week, and a third place finish at the 2013 E Scow National Championship.

Over the years many of us have experienced Porter's expertise as skipper or crew in ILYA classes A, E, M-20, M, and X.

Porter joins the ranks of ILYA sailors who have won the Rolex Yachtsman or Yachtswoman of the year, including Sally Barkow (2005, 2007), Jane Pegel (1964, 1971, 1972) and Buddy Melges (1961, 1971, 1972), and a long list of nationally and internationally famous U.S. sailors. # In Memoriam...

*F. Edward Treis, Richard Casper, Donald Williquette*

*The ILYA remembers with great respect and appreciation the lives and service of three beloved Inland members who spent so many years in selfless service to the ILYA.*

**Richard J. Casper, Sr.** was passionate about sailing and people. Dick was recently named the Inland Lake Yachting Association member of the year in recognition of creating the Bilge Pullers' ILYA Hall of Fame in 2004, bi-annual induction to which remains a highly-regarded honor to this day. Dick had also served as Admiral of the Bilge Pullers.

**Donald J. Williquette** was responsible for a sea change in ILYA race management in the 1970s when he helped the Inland move from a race officer corps under the direction of a hired judge from the east coast to an extensive group of very proficient volunteer race officers. "Uncle Donald" organized, trained, and nurtured race officers that ultimately staffed home lake races, the Interlake, the WYA, and virtually every local regatta for decades. He was often seen on the water with his dear friends and associates Snake and Snuff Schneider and Herman Barkow. His passion for race management

and his gift for handling all the different personalities in his stable of race officers, along with his decades of unsung service to the ILYA, earned him the title of Chairman Emeritus of the ILYA Race Management and Judges Committee, one of the few Emeritus titles ever granted by the ILYA.

**F. Edward Treis**, known to us as Ed, started working at a printing company, later bought it, and with a 'can-do' attitude turned it into an international company with over 750 employees. His competitive spirit found a release in sailing. For more than 50 years he was a competitive sailor—winning championships, volunteering with the Inland Lake Yachting Association and serving as commodore of the Delavan Lake Yacht Club, where he was instrumental in setting up its first sailing school program.

Ed served for many years on the ILYA Board as Treasurer, and was elected Commodore in 1979.

### Fleet Council Meeting 10:00 a.m.

Feel free to sit in on this first official meeting of the ILYA Fleet Council. The ILYA Rules Committee has always been comprised of representatives of the ILYA sanctioned fleets plus two at-large members and the committee chairman. By action of the ILYA Board last October, the ILYA Rules Committee will now be known as the ILYA Fleet Council. As the ILYA's responsibilities in writing class scantlings and racing rules diminishes, the Fleet Council can be more productive in fleet and regatta promotion, and coordinating efforts with the Race Management and Judges Committee.

### Build a 420 Program 10:00 a.m.

Sailing doesn't just begin on Memorial day and end on Labor Day. Many ILYA Clubs and affiliated Sailing Schools keep our juniors active in the early spring and late fall with 420 high school and other programs. And the Club 420 is sanctioned by the ILYA as the post Opti/X Boat youth boat and enjoys an ILYA Championship Regatta every year. ### *Racing Clinic 2:45 p.m.*

## ILYA master sailors excel at Laser Worlds in Oman

It's not only our youth sailors excelling around the world. Steve Avery of Okoboji and Bruce Martinson (Minnetonka) sailed beautifully at the Laser World Championships in the Sultanate of Oman. Avery won the first race in the Great Grand Master Radial division. Bruce Martinson won four races in the Radial Grand Masters division, including the last two of twelve.

Martinson finished the December event in second place overall. This achievement comes on top of being recently awarded the title of ISAF Judge, a title most difficult to attain, and rare in the US. Long time crew Martinson sails regularly in the E scow fleet.

Evidently chairing the ILYA Annual Championship Regatta at Okoboji in August did not deplete C Scow and MC Scow sailor Steve Avery. Avery took fifth place in the Radial Great Grand Masters Division of the Laser World Championship Regatta. The Great Grand Masters Division is for skippers over age 65.

Avery reflects, "I do have to say that when over the PA it came out 'in 5th place representing the United States of America, Mr. Steve Avery,' I had a pretty big spring in my step and a pretty wide grin and proud feeling."

## Sailing School membership in ILYA on Delegates' agenda

ILYA By-Laws provide for two types of membership: individual and club. At the individual level we have about eight different categories which reflect the variety of interests we have in joining the ILYA. At the club level we only have one—yacht clubs.

The ILYA Board has been reviewing and discussing club membership for a few years now. There has been some interest in expanding the club level to include sailing schools as well as yacht clubs. Many yacht clubs also are affiliated with a sailing school, so for the majority of our members this would be redundant and not make economical sense for the yacht club and sailing school. However, with the growth of youth fleets and different classes there is a variety of reasons to expand.

There are numerous IOD and 420 fleets at clubs that do not host scow races—Milwaukee, South Shore and Lake Forest, to name a few. As many of these youth attend our events under various exceptions in our By-Laws, there are those who believe we should reach out to these sailing schools and look to allow them to become an ILYA member club or school. This would hopefully increase participation at our events.

It has also been suggested that, because the boards of many yacht clubs and sailing schools are different, there would be better communication between the ILYA and its members if the affiliated schools were in the communications loop. Further, sailing schools may have a broader or more diverse base of contacts to reach out to on behalf of the Inland.

There is a proposal on the ILYA Board agenda for the Winter Inland, to change the By-Laws and allow two classes of club memberships—yacht clubs and sailing schools. The proposal would allow sailing schools to join at the same rate as yacht clubs but to only register IODs and 420s. This should allow X Boat fleets and traditional scow classes to be served through their yacht clubs as has been the practice.

The issue will be discussed by the ILYA Club Delegates at their meeting on Saturday, March 1. The ILYA Board will vote on the proposal the next day. ### Proposed Bylaw changes:

#### 1). Article II Types of Membership

Add the following at end of paragraph; "Club memberships shall be of two types, yacht club and sailing schools. Sailing schools shall be limited to becoming a member for 420 and IOD classes only."

#### 2). Article III Club Memberships

In paragraph 3.1, delete the word "yacht" in 2 places such that just the word "club" is retained.

In paragraph 3.4, delete the word "yacht" in 1 place such that just the word "club" is retained.

Note, throughout the remaining bylaws, reference is made to "member clubs" which would refer to both YC and SS under article II.

# Board of Directors meets in Hudson

Minutes  
October 27, 2013  
Hudson House Grand Hotel  
Hudson, Wisconsin

Commodore Friend called the meeting to order at 8:34 a.m. The following officers were present: Commodore Friend, Vice Commodore Schmidt, Secretary-Treasurer D. Porter, and Past Commodore Trester. The following Directors-at-Large were present: Cox, Haines, Kotovic, Oltrogge, Weston, and Wyman. Driessen and Reilly were absent. The following Fleet Representative Directors were present: Alnes, V. Porter, JP Porter, Whealon, Haeger, Biwer, Spencer, Zaiser, and Woldum. Hollister was absent. At-Large Rules members Simon and Keck were absent. Measurer D. Schmidt was absent. Executive Secretary Smith, RM&J Committee Chairman Mann, Appeals/Historian Chairman Hodgson, and ScowLines Editor C. Porter were present. Guests included Andy and Finn Burdick, Pat Fleming, and Bill Wyman.

## Initial Actions:

- The minutes of the Feb. 10, 2013 Board and Rules Committee Meetings were approved (Alnes/Weston).
- The actions of the Exec. Cmte. were approved (Haines/Weston). These included:
  - Cuba Lake Yacht Club (NY) as a member club
  - Bylaw 80.6 B.1. All measurement bands shall be one inch wide and of contrasting color to the spars. The band shall completely encircle the spars.
  - Bylaw 80.6 B.2. All measurement bands must be permanently affixed, either painted, permanent decals, or tape of sufficient quality, but may not be adjustable.
  - In support of Wisconsin concussion awareness initiatives, ILYA will publish concussion information in *Scow Slants* annually.
  - Cancellation of 2013 A Scow Invitational Regatta.

## Rules Committee:

- Recommendations of the Rules Committee were approved (Trester/Weston). These included:
  - Changes to Fleet Guidelines to the Race Committee:
    - IOD—Apply 20 minute secondary time limit to IOD RWB and Green fleets, but not No Tears events.
    - IOD—Change Code Flag P start from 'RC Option' to 'No' for RWB and Green fleets, but not No Tears events.
    - Class C—Change Code Flag P start from 'No' to 'RC Option'
    - Class C—Outside help after capsize ('Yes') also includes outside help for crew overboard (SIs to be explicit)
    - Class C—Add category Charlie Minus: 'NO' with footnote "Only if change in course direction and lack of lake area requires it or it is part of an RC announced plan to shorten the first leeward leg of a race."
  - Changes to Sailing Instructions:
    - Under SIGNALS MADE ASHORE (SI 6.x): Delete the following SI: ~~When flag AP over H is displayed~~

~~ashore, it means: "No boat shall leave the harbor. Wait for further instructions." This changes Race Signals, AP over H.~~

- Under THE START (SI 13x): ~~If a General Recall is signaled or~~ If the race is abandoned after the starting signal under the Z or Black Flag, all competitors who received a 20% scoring penalty under the RRS 30.2 or were disqualified under the RRS 30.3 in the recalled or abandoned race are again eligible to race without penalty. This changes RRS 30.2 and 30.3.
- Under RECALLS (SI 14x): Following the display of Code Flag "X", the Race Committee will attempt to announce the sail number of all boats identified on the course side of the starting line at the starting signal and boats that must comply with RRS 30.1. Such announcement is a courtesy and failure of the race committee to make the announcement, or of boats to hear or understand it, or the order of the hails, shall not be grounds for granting redress. ~~This changes RRS 62.1.~~
- Under GPS and OTHER ELECTRONICS (SI 24) for Class C only: ~~Strike the entire SI. Competitors may view electronic data that displays course bearing, countdown timer, and any tactical mode derived strictly from course bearing information. The course bearing information may be derived magnetically or via GPS and may store GPS data for review when not racing.~~
- Under OUTSIDE HELP (SI 25x) for Class C only: For the purpose of RRS 41, the crew of a capsized boat ~~or a crew member overboard~~ shall be considered "in danger," and thus eligible to continue racing after being righted. This changes RRS 41.
- Changes to Class C Scantlings:
  - 85.17 should be changed to read as follows: Devices displaying any data derived and or stored via magnetic compass, countdown timer, or GPS signal are permitted.
- Other Fleet actions:
  - Class X requests that emphasis on the requirement that Coast Guard approved PFDs be used by participants per the SIs. ILYA publications and notices to junior coordinators and X fleet members will inform, and regatta officials should enforce.
  - Class IOD
    - Scoring and trophies to be re-instated for No Tears events.
    - Clearly state in NOR that all races sailed shall count for points in the event(s).

## New Business:

- A motion to approve the change of name and charter of the 'Rules Committee' to 'Fleet Council' was approved as follows (Haines/Spencer): The rules committee asks to change the name of the "Rules Committee" to "Fleet Council" and ask to modify the current charter to expand

the committee's duties to include promoting attendance, fleet growth, integrity, and a volunteer spirit within the fleets and races conducted by the ILYA.

- Following lengthy discussion after a report by Kotovic from the committee established to look into the enhancement of the ILYA Championship Regatta experience, the following actions were taken:
  - Board consensus favored partnering with future ILYA Championship host clubs via a model that was used with Mendota 2012, encouraging a championship of 4 or 5 days with multiple fleets attending, and seeking clubs to host the event for 2 to 5 years in a row.
  - Schmidt to form a committee to better define the meaning of partnership and to explore the interest of clubs in hosting the event for 2-5 years in a row.
- Smith was authorized to spend \$300-400 to upgrade the ILYA web site CMS platform (Wyman/Weston).
- No action to change the name of ILYA Invitational Regattas but ILYA publications and all fleet reps are to inform potential attendees that the regattas are open events.
- C. Porter was authorized to proceed with a Women's Clinic/Regatta, possibly annual, to be held first at Beulah or another site if one is interested, on June 19-20, 2014. Request for \$2,000 from Promotion funds was approved (Whealon/Oltrogge).
- Bilge Pullers request for ILYA to set up an account for funds donated to establish a Bilge Pullers ILYA Hall of Fame in the future Buddy Melges Sailing Center (GLSS & LGYC) was approved (Wyman/Schmidt).

### Committee Reports:

- Youth Development will discuss transitioning Sailing School students to Club membership at the Winter Inland. After a discussion regarding the need for clarity on the ILYA's intended progression of youth boats to adult fleets, the consensus was that the ILYA encourages the progression of Opti>X>Scow, and that the 420 is encouraged as a means to keep transitioning high school and college sailors active until they can get into the club adult fleets. To that end, the leaders of the Opti, X, and 420 fleets were instructed to meet with the Youth Development Committee to further define such a path and to recommend means for publicizing it, beginning at the Winter Inland.
- Regatta Coordinating Chair Schmidt thanked 2013 host clubs. Wyman described the racing and social schedule for the 2014 Annual Championship, August 13-17 at Oshkosh for classes A, E, C, I-20. Each fleet will have a morning or afternoon schedule each day, with most back-to-back racing in the afternoon only, except for one day. The Waters is racing and social Headquarters. Felker Cup to be sailed Wed. evening, with opening regatta social to follow. Bilge Pullers is scheduling Thursday evening. Friday and Sat social events at The Waters. Hodgson to oversee the racing schedule which is designed for sailors to compete in more than one fleet and establishes a minimum of 1.5 hours between morning and afternoon scheduling. Race trophies will be awarded at the social events. Overall trophies to be awarded Sun. afternoon.
  - Regattas were awarded as follows:
    - 2014 Regattas (Schmidt/Trester): MC

Championship to Pewaukee Aug. 7-10, MC Invitational to Okoboji July 10-13, No Tears West to Okoboji, IOD No Tears East to Beulah. Smith will pursue and publish unset dates for 2014 events.

- 2015 Regattas (Schmidt/Trester): Annual Championship (A,E, C, MC, I-20) to Geneva, X Champs to Pewaukee July 22-25
- Treasurer Porter presented the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter financial reports and predicted a break even year end. Report approved (JP Porter/Haines).
- Race Management Chair Mann presented the 2014 PROs and Judges assignments for approval (Weston/Schmidt). Milw. YC will host a 2-day seminar Nov. 9-10. Single day training events may be scheduled for Okoboji and Delavan.
- Smith recognized the recent passing of Race Management Chair Emeritus Donald Williquette and reported a successful Snake, Snuff, and Williquette Fund campaign to provide discounted VHF radios and GPS units to ILYA recognized Race Officers of which 16 purchased over 20 units at approximately half price. ILYA will no longer supply shotguns and blanks shells for use at ILYA events relying more on modern signaling devices, air horns or club-provided and operated guns.
- Promotion Chair Oltrogge announce that 65 juniors took advantage of Promotion Committee and NCSSA incentives for regatta entry fee discounts in 2013, and that about 50 ILYA supporters took part in the Support Sticker donation program. Both programs will continue in 2014 and Promotion funding of \$500 will be given to Oshkosh to implement Kattack at the Annual Championship (Oltrogge/Weston).
- Commodore Friend has a temporary reserve at Chenequa Country Club Feb. 8-9 for the 2014 Winter Inland which will include a Hall of Fame presentation. A suggestion to flip the "Winter Inland" to the fall (October) meeting instead of the winter (February) received substantial support and will be investigated after the 2014 Winter Inland, other dates for which will also be explored.
- Foundation Committee Chair Trester will ask the committee to assess the current use of General Foundation funds to see if they could be more focused on building scow sailing and fleet sailing in our clubs and events.
- Appeals Committee Chair Hodgson reported completion of two appeals and near completion of a third.

### Old Business:

- Schmidt proposed for discussion only a bylaw change to broaden the ILYA definition of club membership to allow sailing schools limited membership in ILYA. Under the proposal, sailing schools would be limited to becoming a member for 420 and IOD classes only. Schmidt was instructed to send the by-law changes to the Delegates and to ask for their vote at the Winter Inland.

### Adjournment:

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 3:52 p.m. by consensus.

# Foundation Committee explores a new tack

The X Boat is our best junior training boat. When families become involved in X boating they see the ILYA experience at its finest. They see our focus on families, sailing, sportsmanship, and fun at every event that they attend. On the home lakes new families get to know and learn from the more experienced members. Our best successes with growing our adult classes come from lakes that have had the X Boat experience.

Although our X Boat Championship Regatta attendance remains outstanding, we are also aware that fewer than half of our member clubs race X Boats. We want to bring this great learning experience to more of our members.

The Foundation Committee decided that we want to change gears and promote the X Boat experience by starting new X fleets on our member lakes. We have embarked on a program whereby we will offer grants to individual families that want to buy X Boats to start a new fleet or reactivate a fleet that no longer races.

We are working on the details of how this program might work, but our initial idea is to offer to award a

grant for up to 50% of the cost of an X Boat with a maximum of \$3,000.00 per boat. The idea would be to populate a club with a small beginning fleet. Because of our funding levels we are limiting the total amount to each lake to \$9,000. Eligibility guidelines would include:

- The ILYA member club has no currently active X Boat fleet
- The club agrees to actively support the new fleet and encourage its growth
- Participating families join ILYA as family members
- Participating families agree to campaign the boat at the ILYA X Championship each year that they own the boat
- Member clubs will need a minimum of three boats to start a fleet
- Boats that are purchased with the help of grant funds cannot be sold at a profit

With a small amount of additional funding we could help two lakes start up fleets in the coming year. If you have any interest in becoming involved in this program please contact Rick Trester or Jim Smith for details.

### Team Haeger/Provancha

Team Haeger/Provancha spent the summer racing throughout Europe with great results. Our European tour results included our 1st ISAF World Cup Medal with a bronze at the Princess Sophia Trophy, 7 top-five finishes on the 2013 470 International circuit, 5,689 Kilometers driven, and countless lessons learned.

After returning back to the States in September we spent our fall training in the windy, chilly conditions of the Northeast. October and November were spent on Cape Cod where we had the opportunity to train with several teams. Most of the mens' teams have been to more than one Olympic Games and they provide us with mental and physical challenges. We're proud to say that we really held our own and made excellent progress. Mid-November had us driving the rig back to Fort Lauderdale where we hosted the Swiss men's team for ten days. The conditions in Fort Lauderdale were similar to the East Coast - great wind and waves - but the bonus was that the weather was in the high 70's.

The 470 nationals was our first regatta of this season in November. The men and women raced against each other due to smaller numbers, which enabled us to be able to compete against the veterans! We ended up second, with a lot of room for improvement with our starts. For the past month, we were able to take a few days off of training to spend with our families. The past couple of weeks were packed with long hours of on-the-water training, time spent in the gym, and debriefing with some of the best coaches the US has.

We are so fortunate to have the support of our family and friends and can't thank you enough for all you do. Know that it is because of you that we can forge ahead with our Olympic quest for gold. We are

My Laser Olympic Campaign has been quite hectic the last part of 2013 and into early 2014. I finished off the first full year of my Campaign with the European Championship in September (Dublin, Ireland), and the World Championship in November (Muscat, Oman). It was my first time competing in both of these world class events and needless to say, both regattas were tremendous learning experiences in terms of seeing firsthand the level of skill required to be the best. I learned a ton, however finished in the Silver Fleet both times. December and January are full up with training and racing,

mostly in Florida. In early January I competed at a small event in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, site of the 2016 Olympics. It was great to see the Olympic sailing venue and race against Robert Scheidt, the current Laser World Champion, and several other tough competitors from Brazil.
