## ILYA Optimist Championships Day One

### Tie for First



The competition has been fierce all summer between these two sailors in Optis and X boats. Charlie Allen from Pewaukee and Henry Ackley from Pine (bottom) have been on each other's heels. But younger Pewaukee sailor John Lieber has sneaked in on them also. So the three sailors sit atop the leaderboard after five races in the Red, White and Blue fleet after day one.

The wind was mighty with gusts in the upper twenties. The RWB fleet suffered very few dropouts as the sailors were on the water 10:00 to nearly 6:00 with a brief lunch interlude. These Opti sailors were on the water longer than the preceding X sailors last week. A tough lot with great sailing of five long races. The trapezoid courses were perhaps as long or longer than the X races. These sailors were champions ALL!

New this year was the introduction of judges on the water. Their main function was to

clear the course of proximity to motor boats and to decrease the wave action due to motorboat chop or wash. While there is no control over non-regatta boats on the lake, the judges utilized the USODA model of "zones" where coaches were allowed inside the spectator fleet to get to sailors. Spectators were placed outside the coaching zone. Rule 42 infractions could have been identified but it seems those were rare and a matter of education. This "zone" concept will become more important on our smaller lakes where the courses are impacted more by motorboat space requirements. We have all seen and heard warnings to our spectator fleet at the big events. This practice seemed to be well-received.

Of note in the standings:

- Six of the top fifteen sailors are girls
- Nine different lakes are represented in the top twenty
- There is one sole White Fleeter (youngest age 8-10) in the top 20. ---- Older sailors CAN stay in the Opti.

Today's wind is predicted to be light.

### Meanwhile on the Green side

That same high wind faced the Green or less experienced sailors. Although a bit sheltered more toward the shore, the fleet saw gusts to 22 and frequently 18 mph. Three races in the morning before lunch were deemed a day although the fleet was ready in the afternoon with the following guidelines:

- RWB fleet safely traveling out to course
- Wind gusts at the most 20 MPH but not a steady wind over 15 mph
- Six boats over simultaneously

Immediately upon setting foot on the boat, the RC saw gusts at 27-29MPH. Sailing was abandoned for the day for the Green Fleet. SWIM TIME! The White Bear Yacht Club was most welcoming to our sailors.

This fleet was amazing in the bigger wind yesterday. There were approximately three DNFs each race but not the same sailors. It was a joy to watch them as each race saw the fleet develop confidence and improved proficiency. The three races were won by Cedar "besties" and there was another Cedar friend right there. All three were X boat crew last week.
