Chapman Petersen/Jack Plummer Win GLSS X Regatta

Four Race Event - Seventy-Seven Boats

Light air plagued day one with two late afternoon races in shifty winds. Day Two was a beauty with steady moderate wind. Each race resulted in a different overall winner but tenacity resulted in a win for Geneva's homelake hero. Chapman Petersen remarked his win last week at the US Sailing Youth Champs was in all ways comparable to the tough competition here with quality sailing.

Take-aways

- Radios are here to stay with the X fleet.
- Use of midline boats on the starting line result in fewer general recalls but many more individual recalls. Kudos to the crew on the LGYC flagship for the speed in setup between races. X sailors were exceptional at clearing off the midline boat.
- GLSS runs an event with ease fostering independence in boat launching
- Volleyball rules - even with the instructors as the Dream Team reigns. Beulah won the sailors' volleyball even without the Barr/Schmidt height.
- Marek Valasek is the most gracious emcee thanking and appreciating the efforts of many.
- The list of names from longtime sailing families is remarkable below but the addition of new families promises a bright future for scow sailing.
- Cedar Lake came to compete - five in the top twenty. This program consciously made a decision about five years ago to invite non-lake sailors to join the club. Adult sailors from Milwaukee YC joined its MC fleet and many, many youth came from Slinger/West Bend. The result is 20 X boats gathered on the site for a whole lot of fun each race. The homelake boats moved from their at-home moorings to the club and it's a party each weekend with a grill out. The growth of the fleets has been impressive and

Notes before the X and Opti Inland

What fleet should my child sail?

All birthdays in youth fleets for eligibility to participate are based on 1/1/19. This is chosen to insure our sailors do not age out midseason. All who begin to sail in May are eligible throughout the 2019 season.

X boats - Junior or Senior

- All registrations are **based on the age of the skipper**. A crew in either fleet can be any age -- within the eligibility of NOT SIXTEEN on 1/1/19.
- **All sailors are entitled to two years in the Senior Fleet** - that is the easiest way to say it.
- Your sailor MAY be driving in the last year of X boats -- if they have a spring birthday. Yes, it's scary but it happens that way. Turning 16 in the fall means you are not eligible for the following year.
- If you are 13 and under, you are a junior. If you are 15, you are a senior (you may be sixteen). It's that 14-year old that needs a second look. How old was your child on 1/1/19? If fourteen on 1/1/19, you are a senior. If your child's birthday is 1/2/19 or after, the sailor is a junior.
- Plain as mud? Ask for someone to help with the fourteen year old if you have questions. You may register and correct that categorization on registration day at Minnetonka --- you won't be the only one!

Optimists

The eligibility for the year is again based on 1/1/19. X and Opti sailors age out based on the same date. That is to allow the lakes who have both fleets to answer the eligibility question the same way. For our lakes with only Optis, it keeps your sailors sailing as long as possible.

- **Red, Blue and White age is based on the age of the sailor on the day of registration.** That day may precede the actual first race like White Bear ILYA Championships, for instance. Red sailors are 13 and up; Blue 11-12 and White 10 and under
- **Green fleet is based on skill rather than age.** Your sailing school coach is your best resource to help you determine the appropriate time to progress from Green to RWB. There is NO RULE that says one year in Green and then graduate out. If your child is roll-tacking, knows and expects all the rules to be reinforced, knows how to setup on a starting line, sails consistently well upwind recognizing shifts, confident in heavier wind, knows the sail adjustments for light and heavy air and basically knows tactics and has confident boat handling, it is time to move up. Most sailors spend 2 years in Green fleet but the 6-8 year old may still be Green longer due to the calmer nature of our Inland Lakes. We start our sailors at a much younger age than the coasts. Most sailing schools are teaching four year olds here. It is about water acclimation but our smaller lakes promote safer boat handling.
- You may NOT choose your fleet color for each regatta. Once white, your are RWB. No determining this regatta is harder so I will move back down to Green.
- **NO TEARS** - this is an anomaly, not following USODA guidelines. This was an invention of the original ILYA Optimist Committee back in the late eighties. This is for our very youngest sailors. It is for those

still in Green. **A RWB sailor NEVER qualifies for NO TEARS.** Last year's winning sailors are not eligible for a second No Tears. **This regatta has two divisions BASED ON AGE:** 8 and under and 9-12. Socially the 13-15 year old beginning Opti sailor will most likely not enjoy this event. This event was formed when the ILYA first adopted Optimist Dinghies into its sanctioned classes. It was called No Tears, No Guns, No Protests. Immediately in year two of the existence of the ILYA Opti fleet, we added a championship regatta with the likes of Barkows, Reeses, Hood, Beukema, Harring, Allens, Porters. So, yes, we are 30 years old now.

If you need help determining your child's placement, ask Chris Allen, Opti Chair or Ted Rolfs, X Chair.
