The NCESA, as a non-profit charitable organization, has established a Fund that is designed to support and promote E-Scow sailing. This Regatta Participation Grant is specifically designed to help those young E-Scow skippers under the age of 30 to attend a major regional regatta they could not otherwise afford.

The NCESA has been for many years supporting skippers under the age of 26 by providing a \$50 entry fee at the National E Championship Regatta, a discount of \$225.

## **Prerequisite/Eligibility**

- The Regatta Participation Grant request must come from a current member of the NCESA.
- A local fleet NCESA member E-Scow owner must vouch/sponsor the person applying for this grant. You can contact the NCESA Secretary (Lon@e-scow.org) for assistance in identifying a current NCESA member in your Fleet.
- The skipper and one other crew member must be under 30 years old at the start of the regatta they want to attend.
- The Grant Application must be received 3 weeks prior to the regatta you plan to use the grant money to attend.
- The boat you are sailing at the regatta shall have liability insurance.
- In the application form below, you will be asked to complete a declaration that essentially says the following:

I hereby declare that my program is not receiving financial support or sponsorship to attend this regatta outside of myself, co-owners, or teammates. Teams with parents who are funding boat ownership and/or

Donate to ILYA or Support your Olympic Contenders NEW X Boat Regatta for our First and Second Year Skippers - Lake Country X Boat Regatta

## The Inaugural Lake Country X Boat Clinic will be hosted by the Pewaukee Yacht Club on Thursday, June 27th and Friday, June 28th.

The Lake Country X Clinic was created in early 2019 by a group of representatives from these six lakes: LacLaBelle, Nagawicka, North, Okauchee, Pewaukee and Pine. This event will rotate annually amongst these six lakes. The goal of this event is to build the confidence of sailors and parents alike with the process and expectations of attending an X boat regatta. This is a beginner-focused event, open to X boat skippers who are new to sailing, or new to traveling for regattas. The committee will accept applications from more advances skippers and will consider making exceptions as they see fit. If your sailor has attended several X boat regattas as a skipper, this may not be a good event for them. This is essentially a Green Fleet event for X boats. This event will be limited to the first thirty (30) boats to register. The on-water drills will focus on landing at a buoy in a mooring field; race starting; and windward mark and gate roundings. Boats will be wetsailed (kept in the water overnight) in the bay directly in from of Pewaukee Yacht Club. A list of suggested items to bring to the clinic will be provided upon registration. Registration will be \$75 per boat and includes two t-shirts and lunch (for skipper and crew) on Friday. Extra lunches will be available for purchase in advance for \$5. Limited amount of extra lunches may be available the day of the event. Parents are strongly encouraged to stay for the duration of the event. There will be parent-focused activites on both Thursday and Friday. Please see the schedule below for more information. Each boat must be accompanied by at least one adult for the duration of the event. Registration begins on May 1, 2019. The link for online registration will be located at www.pyc.org/regattas/LCXC A late fee of \$25 will be in effect as of June 6th, 2019.
