From 2012 until his recent appointment at CofC, Jewett spent much of his time with Sea & Caye coaching high level racers around the country, racing professionally in grand prix classes, and offering consulting services to organizations looking to grow or reorganize.

While at Geneva Lake, Jewett served simultaneously as the Director of Sailing for the Lake Geneva Yacht Club in addition to his duties with the Geneva Lake Sailing School. Jewett hired and managed a staff of 15 coaches, while also handling marketing, managing media and collaborating with the board of directors on fundraising efforts that raised cash reserves by 500 percent. He played an integral role in a capital campaign that raised more than \$3.5 million to build a state-of-the-art sailing center and new home for both the sailing school and yacht club.
