No Tears

Qualifications

The ILYA No Tears is divided into two fleets -- Junior and Senior. This designation is based on age alone, not skill. Junior fleet is 8 and under; Senior 9-12. Last year's top five finishers are not eligible to attend. This event is meant for first and second year sailors. It is lower than a Green fleet event in terms of rules and RC execution of the race. RC at No Tears (and instructors) coach much more and may coach strategy. Officially, per USODA, the Green Fleet sails with full rules. In the ILYA, we discourage protests and do not expect full knowledge of the rules for No Tears. The rules are very simple for the No Tears---port/starboard, windward/leeward, there IS room at the mark, no bumper boats, NO SWIMMING OFF BOATS and ALWAYS, ALWAYS HAVE FUN AND MEET FRIENDS.

Your coach is the best person to evaluate your sailors suitability for the No Tears and Green. With all this said, the first year in the RWB is difficult. If your child is in the back 10-20% of the RWB fleet because you have pushed your sailor up to RWB, does not seem to be making progress, has become entirely discouraged, have a serious discussion with your coach. Often parents and coaches make the progression to RWB too rapidly. Have an honest discussion related to your child's enjoyment and skill level before moving to RWB.
