### Day One

Did you ever pinch yourself to be sure you weren't dreaming? Pewaukee has to be in that position today. Great winds, moderate temperature, three races per fleet. It's been a picture perfect regatta thus far which can be credited to the advance planning. What a testament to all the committee work at PY. Perhaps the biggest improvement is the grounds. A new sand volleyball court located across the street and up the hill to the church - all volunteer labor just for this event. That allows increased seating on the grounds. There are 500-600 folks on the property at one time and it feels like a leisurely day on the grass. What a tremendous plan this was. The volleyball tournament takes team after team off site (with parents) and yet you feel like you are in the thick of all the activity. No one was in a hurry to leave Thursday night. Sailors enjoying sailors - rekindling friendships and welcoming the new families to the ILYA system.

The highlights of the day ---

- Minnetonka!!! What rapid growth for a non-existent fleet just four years ago. They will host us in 2019 and bets are on for 30 boats by next year. There are Hughes, Zinns, Strothmans, Regans ---- and think of what is to come! Jack and Barb Strothman may win the "grandparents with the mostest" award. Split between Geneva and Minnetonka, those 9's and 10's are prevalent ---- all in the junior fleet. The Jewett - Lynch family might give them a run for their money next year on Minnetonka.
- The change in venue for the sailors --- Chip Mann and Mark Tesar alternated water locations to give the sailors a new look. Thanks to all the RC for their work on the water.
- What a day for the juniors. All 70 started the day but not without attrition. First Leah Johnson lost a mast -- but she returned for Race two of the event.
- Dave Berg reports fifteen lakes are represented. Think of the coach boats, parents boats, RC boats and spectator boats. That's a lot of traffic. The piers look like an inflatable boat jungle. My how things have changed from the stern-driven putt-putts. Coaches provide most of the shuttling now each morning, lunch and evening. They provide moral and physical support. They serve as our safety boats on the course. They are there in an instant to protect our sailors - then they hand them over to the respective coach team. They are, in the editor's view, our single strongest asset on the course.

### Senior Fleet

The Seniors had a more consistent day in terms of skill. Very few DNF's but a tipover also. As you review the results, consider the fleet receives a throwout after six races which is hopefully accomplished after Friday's racing. Thanks to ILYA Judges Chair Bruce Martinson and Rick Roy for establishing our protest teams and new procedures. As part of the #FairSailing initiative, arbitration was added to the mix this year. You will see a scoring penalty below which indicates, in this case, a protest was filed, Rick Roy met with the parties and a short discussion was held at which time a sailor declined the protest procedure and accepted a penalty. The protest committees (there is one for each fleet) consists of Tom Hodgson, John Porter, David Porter, Todd Haines, David Perrigo and Rick Roy. Additionally, Roy and John Porter are acting as arbitrators for the alternate fleets. Thanks in advance and hopefully they will not be called into action. There are penalty turns aplenty on the water and much more matter-of-fact conversation at the marks, "go ahead, tacking, I have room". The efforts of #FairSailing are obvious. RC is monitoring and recording the mark roundings and action (conversations with the PROs) taken with the young sailors. New to us is the "start" of the protest time. The ILYA has utilized "docking time" for an eternity but the Racing Rules of Sailing set the "start time" as the last finishing boat. The ILYA has altered the elapsed time to 90 minutes rather than the RRS stated two hours. Our lakes are small affording us the luxury of getting to shore a bit more quickly than coastal sailing. Still, it requires a change to RC standard practice.

Also new this year is the mandated use of a digital official board. This is maintained through Regatta Toolbox and the ILYA Executive Director Dave Berg. Postings are still made on the window "official" board.
