With cooperation

PROs were communicating throughout the morning as the E's required some time spent in postponement. The two PROs were in contact throughout this process. The C team was ready to go at the appointed time but it became readily apparent the 1:30 was not to work. They were however monitoring the wind and were prepared immediately to set up the course upon hitting the water.

The E PRO was in communication with his sailors who would be sailing next in the C session assuring them we would make this work.

The C signal team was aware of who was on the E course and needed to make it to the C course. This transition occurred in under 45 minutes. The last E boater was checked off the C roster to allow a 2:30 start of sequence.

C sailors on shore were helping sailors on the water. There were surprises as E sailors returned to shore to find boats rigged with only the sail to hoist. C sailors were in sailboats with alternate crews to grab their intended crews off the water if they were on E's. Tenders were plentiful to make this all happen.

Also, off the record for the 2600 of you who receive this, waterfront coordinator Chris Jewett was in contact with the RC committee to begin to construct some alternate plans if the wind remained low all morning for the E's. And, no, it was not huge fans run from the Wayzata shore to create wind. Discussions and alternate plans regarding sailing schedules in terms of start times. There has been foreplanning all along the way. There is much behind the scenes alternate scenario discussion. This event is about providing the best sailing experience we can have for the fleets.

The PRO waited patiently for the predicted wind. With a direction NOT predicted by numerous agencies, the fleet got started about an hour late with 5-8 MPH wind in a steady direction of NNW. That wind would hold throughout the day much to the delight of the sailors in both fleets. (And so much for the wind predictors) Thanks to the crack team of Minnetonka/Wayzata markset boats for the fast windward marksets and all the local knowledge. The local team has been handling markset on both the E and C courses. All the local team has the local airports on their weather apps. It is most helpful as we watch the day's progression. Thanks also for the fine electronics on the boats which tell us of a reef and other underwater anomalies for faster anchor sets.

Two Geneva boats won the races yesterday. It is a Minnetonka-Geneva lovefest up in the top ten. Even the W-66 boat has Geneva connections since Eddie Cox sails it in the Geneva home series. These two fleets are huge at their homelakes which makes for tough competition each weekend. Growth of a fleet only creates stronger sailors. These two lakes have the right approach for E's. More and more youth are entering this fleet from X boats. On Pewaukee and Geneva, this is definitely the path taken. The abundance of our youth on these boats is most encouraging for the health of the ILYA and the local clubs. As you will see with the C results listed below, the C fleet boasts the most youth skippers in any class in the ILYA. All our fleets are exceptional in keeping our youth sailing.

C Fleet

The C Fleet RC team had the distinct advantage of 4-5 hours of weather history as they took to the water. This made for the fastest setup ever. All new RC boats appear for the two distinct sessions. The crew is fresh and ready to go. The double duty for the sailors is so welcome and exciting to see. For those with energy enough to pull off this feat, it is sailing from 9:00-5:00. If someone could handle this Minnesota head wave, all would be perfect. Today's forecast is for lighter air but the C's fortunately have four races completed which makes this event official. Thanks to the wind and guidance of PRO Larry Krause.

In the scores below, you will find some UFD initials. This is a U-flag designation which is a kinder, gentler black flag. Those who are over with the flying of this red and white checked flag are not given an opportunity to correct an early start like with the use of the Z flag. They are out of this race and unscored in the place they finished unless the race is postponed or abandoned. So if the wind conditions are such that the line was the culprit and made them go over, the RC may postpone or abandon and the sailor will not be punished in the next race. The black flag is like the baseball umpire's, "YOU'RE OUT!" In the old days, we used to lovingly call this the party flag because you could be the first one to the beer keg since you were removed early from the course. The U flag has been in the rule book for two versions now. It was an experimental flag for four years to test its use. Look at the back of the rulebook to become acquainted with its look and its lineup in the choices for a preparatory flag.

This C fleet is so competitive with the exception of the standout Andy Burdick who is in a class by himself at this and many other events. He can be midfleet and still end up at the top at the finish. With 20 (count them

TWENTY!) boats in attendance, Lake Beulah is nearly one-quarter of the fleet. If you want to sail a C, Beulah is your place. Thanks to the patriarchs of the fleet there, the youth are assisted (coerced, mentored, hamstrung) to enter the C scow immediately after X boats. The C is a great family boat as can be seen by the parent-child combos on many of the boats. Wives are often the third crew.
