If some of the sailing schools are willing to get their boats to coaches it wouldn't be unreasonable to charter at anywhere from \$1000-\$2500 depending on size and condition of boats. I have a waiting list of coaches that I would connect directly with any sailing school willing to charter their coach boats. Ideally sailing schools and coaches would broker their own deals after contact is made as it will get very complicated for our team otherwise. For reference I secured 4 charter company RIBS for \$350 a day (brand new boats).
