US Sailing Regional Symposium in Chicago

Plan now - November 16-18

Hello from US Sailing,

Please join us in Chicago, IL the weekend of November 16 for this fall's Midwest Regional Symposium, followed by a Reach Educator course and a Level 3 Head Instructor/Program Director course all hosted at the Columbia Sailing School.

- Friday, November 16: Regional Symposiums are an opportunity for interested parties to come together to share ideas and tackle the challenges facing the sailing community. In Chicago, the roundtable discussions-sponsored by our partners at the Gowrie Group-will be moderated by a US Sailing representative and follow an agenda designed with the needs of the Midwest in mind. Regional Symposium tickets are \$10 for US Sailing members (\$25 for non-members) and include coffee, snacks, and lunch.
- Saturday, November 17: Reach Educator is a one-day eight hour professional development/training opportunity for teachers and sailing instructors to learn how to implement US Sailing's STEM program and curriculum called Reach. The Reach modules are a great teaching resource for classrooms, sailing centers, yacht clubs, summer camps, or after school programs.
- Saturday, November 17 and Sunday November 18: Level 3 Head Instructor/ Program Director is designed for those who are making the transition to a leadership or management role in their sailing programs. This two-day course contains information on how to manage more effectively, problem, solve, and create a quality environment for students and staff. It is available for certification or audit.
