time World Champion Malcolm Page (Sydney, Australia) as the current Chief of United States Olympic Sailing - - the leader of the United States national team and champion of the overall U.S. Olympic sailing effort.



Malcolm was the inaugural speaker of the newly created "John Simms and Family Lecture Series" which was established to educate, entertain, and inspire both adult and youth of the Lake Geneva Yacht Club and the broader community. Additional luminaries are being slotted for upcoming events.

Page is widely considered the most successful Olympic-class sailor in Australian history. He was honored with a place on the Australian Institute of Sport's "Best of the Best" list in 2011, and in October 2016 was inducted into the Sport Australia Hall of Fame.

Malcolm Page is now at the helm of a cultural shift as the Chief of the US Olympic Sailing Team and is creating pathways and systems for sustainable success from youth sailing in the United States to the pinnacles of the sport. Malcolm was particularly thrilled to spend dedicated time with the ILYA's very own Buddy Melges, both being among a rare few with multiple Olympic Medals and records of domination in the sport.

"There are so many talented youths in our country - All the pieces of the puzzle are here," Page said while speaking at the Lake Geneva Yacht Club and to the Buddy Melges Racing Team. "The history of success of this area and what is being done here is part of that foundation and by 2024 we should again be the number one sailing country in the world. By 2028, we should again be dominating."

Malcolm spent Friday evening at LGYC after touring the Melges and Harken facilities earlier in the day. On Saturday morning, he provided an inspiring kickoff the 2018 Spring training season for the Buddy Melges Racing Team which includes members from across ILYA member clubs and multiple states - - and encourages sailors to join the beginner level with dedicated "green fleet" coaching at each practice.
