### **Seventeen Boats in Inaugural Year**

The Buddy Melges Racing Team and the Geneva Lake Sailing School, under the direction of Executive Director and Head Coach Marek Valasek as well as coaches Eric Bowers and Mac Six, hosted 17 X Boats for its inaugural Spring Clinic on Geneva Lake.

With 34 sailors, the clinic began Saturday morning with a focus on proper rigging and tuning techniques. The sailors spend all of Saturday afternoon on the water in ideal conditions. Sunday brought early morning storms but at the first sign of a window in the squalls, all 17 boats were launched in under 20 minutes and they were off for over four hours of drills. In steady 12-15 knots of breeze, all of the sailors (ages 8-14) showed tremendous overall improvement. On the water sessions were followed up with video debriefs in the classroom.

When polled, these sailors uniformly stated that they couldn't have been happier to kick off the season with such a fantastic coaching experience and they feel like they are a step ahead going into the summer.

#### **Qualifier for US Sailing's Mallory Announced**

#### **US Sailing Adult Championships**

Wayzata YC will host the regatta for the Mallory Cup for adults on Sept 25-29. Each Race Sailing Association is permitted to select one team to represent them at this event. The ILYA has had a request to participate and will be sending a team to this event. The event is in J-22s. If you are interested in representing the ILYA, please contact Commodore Porter by May 30th.



The qualifier will be a regatta jointly attended by the ILYA hopefuls and the Twin City Racing Sailing Federation. The two groups will sail together but be scored separately. Matt Thompson and his crew will officiate. Jeff Cameron and Odelle Tuttle of Wayzata will serve as the regatta leadership.

Wayzata has chosen June 23-34 as the qualifier. Mark your calendars now since the date is firm. Fees and other plans will be forthcoming soon. This is a BYOB (BOAT) event. The Wayzata fleet is planning to support the event so many of the home lakes are taken by their owners. It would be wise to secure boats now. Below are extra US Sailing stipulations for the event which apply for the qualifier also.

Qualification

- Teams must be made up of sailors from the RSAs they are representing and members of sailing organizations that are members of that RSA.
- Team members must be current members of US Sailing
- Sailing organizations must be current members of US Sailing
- The event will be sailed in J22s using the league sailing format
- The minimum number of crew for the event shall be four including the helmsperson.
