

Qualifier for US Sailing's Mallory Announced - Resumes Due Sunday, June 10th

US Sailing Adult Championships

Change Wayzata YC has chosen to not combine the qualifier from the ILYA and their RSA. Wayzata YC will host the regatta for the Mallory Cup for adults on Sept 25-29. Each Race Sailing Association is permitted to select one team to represent them at this event. The ILYA has had a request to participate and will be sending a team to this event. The event is in J-22s. If you are interested in representing the ILYA, please contact David Porter.



Selection will be by resume which should be submitted to Commodore Porter by June 10th. Please include:

- your participation in the ILYA in past three years or further past
- list of crew members if you are selected for this event, assure they are members of the ILYA (skipper and crew) and US Sailing (list US Sailing number)
- · indication of your sailing successes
- experience in the J-22 or other keelboat
- other pertinent information which will help determine your selection for this event

Qualification

- Teams must be made up of sailors from the RSAs they are representing and members of sailing organizations that are members of that RSA.
- Team members must be current members of US Sailing
- Sailing organizations must be current members of US Sailing
- The event will be sailed in J22s using the league sailing format
- The minimum number of crew for the event shall be four including the helmsperson.

Pistakee - STEM Education in Sailing School Curriculum



The Community Sailing School @Pistakee is off to our strongest start ever. As we launch our 6th year of transforming kid's lives, we are hosting a three day Sailing Plus STEM class that began yesterday. We have 30 middle school kids attending this new class.

STEM is the national program to enhance education for Science, Technology, Engineering and Math. This program is a validated national education program offered across the United Stated and it targets middle school students. It is a unique blend of STEM applied to the sport of sailing.

We have been partnering with US Sailing for several to develop our STEM expertise and curriculum for several years We've hosted two STEM Reach Instructor training courses and several of us are certified US Sailing STEM Reach Instructors. And this year we received a \$3,000 grant from US Sailing to expand our STEM program!
