These two magnificent trophies were donated to the event or WI MC Championships by Pine Lake. The trophy on the left will be presented annually to the winning skipper. Pine engraved the prior years' winners on the tray. The trophy on the right is from Lake Geneva and was in Walter Schwarting's collection. Win and Margaret Hollister retrieved the trophy, Pine Lake re-fit it, re-mounted it and dedicated it to the WI Champs organization. The trophy will be presented each year by the hosting club. As its name implies, Fair Sailing Award, the trophy will be presented to a sailor who exemplifies dedication to the honor of the sport. What a fitting name for this year as our ILYA endeavor brings attention to preserving and respecting the rules of the sport. Bill Best of Cedar Lake, WI, is the first recipient of the Fair Sailing Award. Bill has singlehandedly created and promoted this event. Biersach said the MC fleet is among the friendliest and most welcoming fleets he ever has encountered and this award is meant to endorse and encourage that spirit.
