Again four great races but one sailor dominated the top. Kyle Navin and Mya Burdick won THREE races. While that is so rare in the senior fleet, there is no room to breathe or celebrate the day. Hometown favorite Nathan and Graham Hetzler are showing a strong, strong start and will prove to be a challenge only eight points out of the lead.

The senior fleet is a bit more aggressive on the starts with a couple recalls but to be fair the wind was a bit less steady than on the junior end of the lake. The sailor to watch in the senior fleet with a throwout is Sam Spencer. Both fleets are scheduled to sail eight races with a throwout at six.
