Reilly Gives Emotional Nod to Boober Schneider and Jerry Huse



Okoboji was excited with its hosting of the 2017 C Nationals but saddened by the death of Jerry Huse's wife on the eve of the event. Boober Schneider appeared at Sunday's trophy presentation to the delight of many as the fleet recognized the legends of Okoboji. The walls display the history of these two forefathers. As Reilly remarked, the C fleet was sailing almost on hallowed water due to the legacy of such accomplished sailors.

Reilly and Pistay with third crew Austin Jaessing displayed a consistency all event. The throwout for the winner was a sixth! 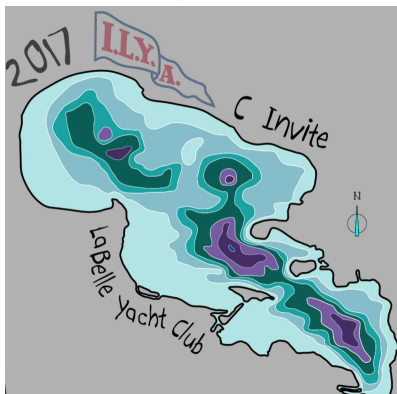
