It seems early but this is your time to get your instructors registered in the course that allows them to fit their sports, prom, graduation activities. This course does NOT teach sailing. It teaches your instructor to plan classes, to know how to evaluate your site for safety, how to deal with discipline problems (Parents - really? and sailor), how to communicate well on the water and land to directors, parents and sailor. There is some sports psychology thrown in. The course is intense with homework each night. Each candidate gives presentations which allows the class to cover loads of info but also gives practice on communication and presentations - in front of their peers so they can critique themselves among good friends. It is advantageous to room with someone for the course so you can work together in the evenings. The ILYA member clubs have worked hard to obtain good instructors. From personal experience, there is no one better than Cappy Capper to lead your young instructors to the next level. He will empower them with experienced knowledge which will allow them to succeed. There are many scheduled dates on the US Sailing education calendar so pick a date that works with your youth instructors' busy schedule. Registration is first-come and only available from US Sailing. There is no "holding" a spot by the local host.

Rules and Tactics Course - UW- Milwaukee - Dave Dellenbaugh, March 5th

Sponsored by North U

The Rules & Tactics Seminar teaches all the rules (not just the new ones) and their underlying principles. You'll know your rights and obligations in every situation and understand how to resolve the conflicts and transitions between the rules as positions change. We'll go all the way around the course, covering the rules in the way you use them - not by the numbers, but through situations on each leg of the course. You will learn to recognize situations and understand which rules apply.

But that is not all. The rules shape and control tactics. The Rules Seminar teaches how to position your boat to tactical advantage so you control the game and avoid positions that leave you vulnerable to attack. You'll also learn the critical difference between right-of-way and control.
