Head Sailing Instructor

Job Summary

Cedar Lake Yacht Club is seeking a talented results-driven head sailing school instructor. Youth sailing at CLYC includes Optis, X-boats and, 420s. The ideal candidate will have successful sailing experience, prior instructor, and prior leadership experience. This position reports to the CLYC Sailing

School Committee.

Job Responsibilities

- Develop daily lesson plans utilizing curriculum provided
- Utilize video instruction when applicable
- Direct sailing school instructor staff on daily lesson plans
- Coach the racing team during daily practice and regattas
- Set goals for each student and work with each student and instructors to achieve goals
- Communicate with parents independently and in weekly updates
- Conflict resolution for students, instructors, and parents
- Create weekly schedule for instructors to ensure proper staffing of all programs. Review instructor timesheets bi-weekly.
- Develop regatta schedule for instructors based on number of racers attending
- Ensure Zodiacs and pontoon are in good working order and filled with gas for sailing school
- Communicate Zodiac and pontoon issues with CLYC Building and Grounds committee
- Assist with rigging, launching, and tuning boats at regattas as needed
- Manage other Sailing School instructors on the CLYC team. Commit
 to working as a team, fostering strong working relationships, and be
 supportive of improving the efforts of fellow instructors.
- Ensure that Club X and Opti boats and sails remain in good working order throughout the season and are properly cared for by sailors.
- Create a safe and positive learning experience for all participants.
- Safe boat handling and proper care of the CLYC clubhouse and equipment.
- Abide by and enforce CLYC Sailing School policies.

Job Skills and requirements

- US Sailing Level 1 Certification required. Higher preferred.
- Completion of Boaters' Safety required
- CPR, AED and, FIrst Aid Certification required prior to June 1st
- The head instructor must be able to effectively communicate with the sailors, their parents, sailing school committee and other instructors
- Skilled in organization, time management, and administrative tasks
- Experience working with classroom and on-the-water instructional methods preferred
- 2 years experience instructing sailing of small boats in a competitive environment preferred
- Strong knowledge of rules of sailing; completion of ILYA Fair Sailing curriculum
- A valid driver license required

Sailing Instructor

Job Summary

Cedar Lake Sailing School is seeking talented results-driven sailing school instructors. The successful candidate will have prior competitive sailing experience and a strong desire to work with youth to achieve sailing success. This position reports to the Head Sailing Instructor.

Job Responsibilities

- Implement daily lesson plans under direction of Head Instructor
- Utilize video instruction when applicable
- Coach the racing team during daily practice and at regattas
- Lead groups of students in classroom learning
- Provide on-water instruction
- Coach the racing team during daily practice and regattas
- Assist with rigging, launching, and tuning boats at regattas as needed
- Other duties as assigned

Job Skills and Requirements

- US Sailing Level 1 Certification, or higher preferred
- Completion of Boaters' Safety required
- CPR and AED Required prior to June 1
- FIrst Aid Certification preferred
- Strong communication skills, including working with the sailors, their parents, the sailing school committee and other instructors
- Strong knowledge of rules of sailing; completion of ILYA Fair Sailing curriculum
- Valid driver license required

US Sailing Level One Instructor Course

COURSE LENGTH

This is a 4-day, 40-hour course. Attendance at all 40 hours is mandatory. Absence from any portion of the course excludes the instructor candidate from certification.

MINIMUM AGE REQUIREMENT

All candidates must have reached their 16th birthday within the calendar year that the course is being held in. Candidates under 18 years of age who complete the course will be designated as a Sailing Assistant until their 18th birthday.

PREREQUISITES FOR ENTRANCE INTO THE COURSE

Below are some of the primary prerequisites for the Level 1 Course. A full list is available during the registration process.

- Sailing experience in small boats, such as prams, dinghies, multihulls or daysailing keelboats.
- Current US Sailing Individual, College or Family Membership (youth membership is not applicable and only one instructor is allowed per family membership)
- Experience operating a safety boat. This course is evaluative: Powerboat skills are tested, not taught, during this course.
- Ability to swim 50 yards both with and without life jacket.
- National Association of State Boating Law Administrators (NASBLA) Safe Boating certification. Candidates who do not hold a NASBLA approved Safe Boating Certificate will not be allowed to operate a powerboat during the course. Online courses that are not NASBLA approved will not be accepted. BoatUS is one provider of online courses. Click here to see all available Boat US courses. You can also earn your certification at one of US Sailing's Safe Powerboat Handling Courses or see a current list of approved providers. Candidates holding a current USCG full or limited Master's or OUPV license are exempt from this requirement.
- ***NEW*** Coming for 2019 Teaching and Coaching Fundamentals Online course - Details will be released after 2/1/19
- SAFESPORT: Beginning on 1/1/2018. This program, developed by the US Olympic Committee, is required training for all Instructors. This requirement is also being put in place for other National Governing Bodies. This free online training course must be completed every 2 years. Instructor certification is not active unless SafeSport training has been completed

TAKE THE TRAINING

<u>Check the US Sailing calendar here</u> but Pewaukee will offer a course in early May. That course will be taught by Emlie Barkow. Parents, consider sending your instructor during Spring Break or look to Chicago if the Pewaukee dates do not work. AP high school testing is the following week.
