Future ILYA Regatta Bids

Submit before October 31

It's time to consider your 2017-18-19-20 bids for all classes of the ILYA. The ILYA Championships have been awarded through 2020. The rest of the classes have openings. For 2017, the I-20 and Melges 17 classes need hosts for their championships. This can be a combined or separate regatta.

Anticipated participation is maximum 30 so your homelake racing, in some cases, could also occur. The Saturday party could be spectacular with your club and the regatta guests.

2018 - Nearly everything is open as a possibility. The ILYA Champs go to Minnetonka but the X and Opti Champs as well as the above-mentioned 2017 openings and all Invitationals are still open for bid.

2019 - ILYA Championships go to Oshkosh but all else is welcome for bid.

2020 - ILYA Championships go to Okoboji but, again, all else is open.

The Board considers many factors when awarding a bid - most importantly, a geographical distribution of the events or a historical rotation which the fleet committee recommends; strong homelake fleets so guaranteed numbers of the fleet will result in a financial success for the club; much less frequently a sparsely populated home lake so fleet promotion can occur; past fine execution of an event. The fleet committees make strong recommendations to the fleets so in addition to submitting a bid to Dave Berg, send your suggestion to the fleet reps:
