Pink, Pink, Pink


Optis gaining confidence in big wind, X sailors showing their exceptional boat handling skills, 420s just learning, and adult women who had never been on boats, had little experience with RC work or just had questions --- all met on Big Cedar to don pink to sail.





The PROS were Maggie Shea and Sally Barkow of Team Magenta and Janel Zarkowsky of Georgetown coaching and Epic Racing Team. These heavy hitters had instant admirers and loads of fun. The adjustments necessary due to changing conditions makes this coaching most challenging. For instance, a Milwaukee sailor arrived to be shocked to find flat-bottomed scows. She spent the afternoon on Barkow's coach boat and declared, "never have I learned so much. I could see the immediate result of a simple

coaching tip by Barkow." A mom arrived on day two to say she had never been on a boat; same thing on day one- a wife had never been on her husband's boat --- this is an opportunity to try new experiences not under the pressure of a racing situation. A Green Fleeter in Optis was overwhelmed by the big wind. She ended up sailing as a crew on a 420 with Maggie Shea. The little sailor lives in Hong Kong and Maggie will be there in September. A match made immediately from one little clinic that is so special.
