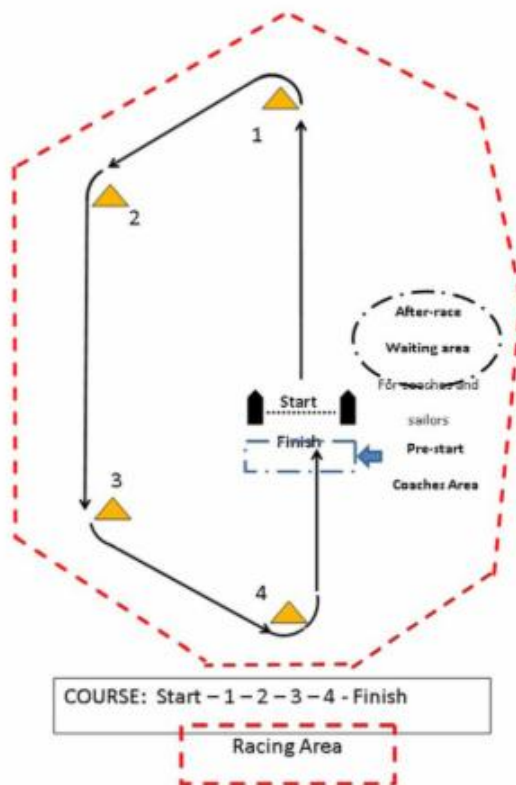

New Course Added for ILYA Optimist Championships

ILYA IOD Opti 2016 Trapezoid Course



Upto 7 knots of wind:

In order to get a 35 minute race (+/-3) in 5-7kts, Optis need to sail about 1.6-1.8 nm.

Start to Mark 1	0.4 nm
Mark 1 to Mark 2	0.3 nm
Mark 2 to Mark 3	0.5 nm
Mark 3 to Mark 4	0.3 nm
Mark 4 to Finish	0.3 nm

The right side of the course is 0.7 nm.

Above 8 knots of wind

In order to get a 35 minute race (+/-4) in 8kts plus, they need about 2.0-2.2 nm.

Start to Mark 1	0.5 nm
Mark 1 to Mark 2	0.35 nm
Mark 2 to Mark 3	0.6 nm
Mark 3 to Mark 4	0.35 nm
Mark 4 to Finish	0.4 nm

The right side of this course is 0.9 nm.

For 2016, the Opti Committee and Fleet Meetings have overwhelmingly requested the use of a Trapezoid course at the ILYA regatta. Therefore, we voted to use the Trapezoid course and approved it, the ILYA sub-committee Fleet Council and the board itself accepted this course, and it has been written into the NOR. Thereafter we needed to sail on a larger lake that would give us the space necessary for this type of course, which has been fulfilled with the host location for 2016 at Clear Lake Iowa. The great news is we have a complete plan and commitment from everyone, most importantly our PRO for the 2016 Regatta Charlie MacNider. The last step is that we would like all Sailing Schools to instruct on the new course usage to prepare our sailors before the regatta. So, I am writing this e-mail to give you all the background on the reasons for the course, and its dimensions

Reasons to use this course:

1. The Trapezoid course allows for easy starts and finishes to increase our racing, and minimize

turnaround time between races.

2. The finish location has a designated place for meeting up with coaches and parents, so as to not disrupt the fleet still racing.
3. Boats that have rounded the windward mark sail toward a reach mark, before proceeding downwind. This minimizes the safety concern of sailing back down through the fleet. A straight windward leeward course means the lead boats turn immediately through the fleet. With 80+ boats and variety of experience some very close calls in past years. Further, unfair circumstances have effected racer results.
4. The final leg of the race is always upwind.
5. The race length and timing is more easily managed - target time of 35 minutes.
6. The above reasons will in fact increase the "on shore lunch/hydration/socialization" intent that is the culture of ILYA Inland events.

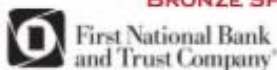

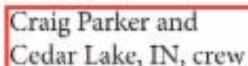
