College Nationals - Yale Takes Team Race Title

Malcolm Lamphere now has two national titles under his belt this collegiate year. He was singlehanded national champ in the Fall and now has completed another national championship in the second of three national championships determined in San Diego. Also competing in the Team Race Nationals portion of the Championships were Tim Siemers (Eckerd - Wayzata), Augie Dale (Old Dominion - Pewaukee) and Leslie Poole (Wisco - Delavan).

Co-ed Nationals follow directly on the heels of Team Racing. The schools are currently in the semifinals portion which lasts two days. Semis conclude today and finals begin with the top nine teams from each semifinal.
