Chicago is pleased to welcome the Louis Vuitton America's Cup World Series (ACWS) to the freshwater of the Great Lakes for the first time in history on June 10 - 12, 2016. As a local Midwest club and sailing advocate, we wanted to personally reach out to ensure that you've received group pricing information & had a direct contact should you have any questions. We hope you will encourage your club members to join us in the Windy City for this historic event! All six America's Cup teams will be in town accumulating points towards the America's Cup Finals, which will be held in Bermuda in June 2017. The racing against Chicago's magnificent skyline will be incredible; as you're aware the teams will be "flying" in the high performance AC45F catamarans that feature a 77' tall wing sail and foils that allow the boats to reach speeds of 40+kts.

Here's a preview of the weekend schedule:

- THURSDAY, JUNE 9: Endeavour Day and AC45 boat launching at Navy Pier. The Endeavour Program is an educational initiative for Chicago youth with components in boating and environmental conservation.
- FRIDAY, JUNE 10: Practice day for teams
 - o1:30 3 PM: Fleet & match racing practice
 - o7:30 PM: Opening ceremony party
- SATURDAY & SUNDAY, JUNE 11&12: Race Days! The LVACWS Race Village at Navy Pier opens at 11AM and will include live broadcast coverage on America's Cup history, America's Cup sailors meet and greet + poster signings, and the best vantage point to watch the racing with all race courses focused around the east end of Navy Pier.
